

HOW TO MAKE A PIG SOCK PUPPET



FOR 1 PIG:

- 1 SOCK
- 1 BUTTON
- 2 GOOGLY EYES
- FELT FOR EARS
- 1 PIECE OF CARDBOARD ABOUT 1.5" WIDE AND 4" LONG
- HOT GLUE GUN
- OPTIONAL: POM POMS AND FELT FOR THE MOUTH

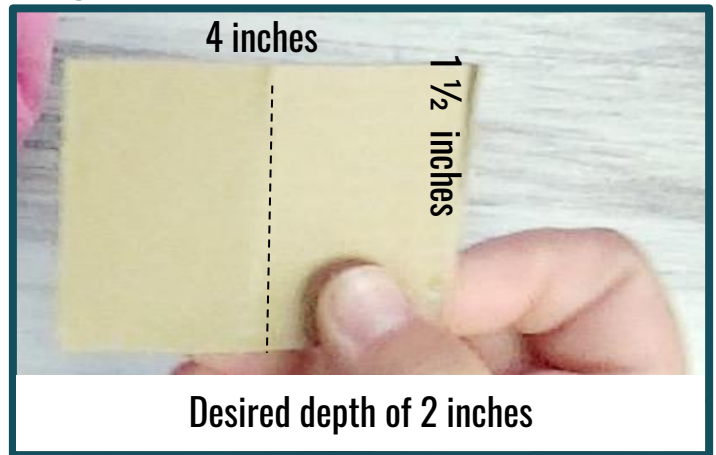

Steps:

1. Turn the sock wrong side out
2. Cut a piece of cardboard just smaller than the width of the toe of the sock and 2x the desired mouth depth (see Pic 1)
3. Fold the cardboard in half (shown by dotted line in Pic 1)
4. Glue onto the toe of sock (see Pic 2)
5. Turn sock right side out, keeping the mouth tucked in (see Pic 3)
6. Cut out an oval circle to fit inside the mouth (see template on next page)
7. Glue circle inside the mouth (see Pic 4)
8. Glue button nose directly on top of mouth (see cover photos). Make sure you keep the heel on the top of the puppet.
9. Glue the googly eyes onto the pig (optional: glue eyes onto felt or pom poms)
10. Cut out ears from template on next page.
11. Glue small ear onto middle of large ear (see Pic 5).
12. Wrap ears around a pencil and place under a book to create a curl.
13. Glue ears into place.
