Sock Rabbit

Supplies:

- 1 pair of socks
- Embroidery Floss
- Buttons (optional)
- Sewing Needle
- Sewing Machine (optional)
- Scissors
- Poly-Fil
- Sewing pins
- Marking Pen
- Ribbon (optional)


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
STEPS:

- 1. Turn the sock inside out and flip one heel side up (sock 1) and the other on its side (sock 2).
- 2. Cut out the heel of the Sock 1.
- З. Mark your sewing lines shown in yellow in Pic 1.
- 4. Sew on your sewing lines, making sure to back stitch at the beginning and end of each seam you sew.
- 5. Cut around your sewing lines, making sure to leave a space so you don't accidently cut your seams.
- Cut off and save the toe of Sock 6. 1 to be used as the rabbit tail later on.
- 7. Turn all parts right-side out.
- 8. Stuff the legs and arms. Set aside.
- Stuff the body and sew shut. 9.
- 10. Iron ears flat.
- Fold each ear in half at bottom 11. and sew together. See Pic 2.
- 12. Pin arms, legs and ears in place. Attach with needle and thread. See Pic 3.






- 13. Do a gathering stitch all around the edge of the toe of Sock 1. See Pic 4.
- 14. Stuff the the toe with Poly-Fil.
- 15. Pull the gather stitch tight to close the opening. Then sew it tightly shut. Creates the tail.
- 16. Attach the tail to the rabbit. See Pic 5.
- 17. Stitch on mouth and nose using coordinating thread. See Pic 6.
- 17. Sew the eyes on. NOTE: If Giving this to a young child, do not use buttons. Stitch the eyes on with coordinating thread or use safety eyes before stuffing.
- Tie a coordinating ribbon around the rabbit's neck if desired! (securely attach the ribbon if will be used by a child)
