
## EASY DIY SPIDER COSTUME





## **SUPPLIES**

- 1 solid black shirt
- 1 solid black pants
- 2 pairs black socks
- Black yarn
- Black thread
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Optional: Black hat and black makeup

## **STEPS:**

- Put the shirt on the costume wearer and mark where you will put the 4 additional legs (See Pic 1)
- 2. Lightly stuff 4 long black socks, just enough to hold their shape.
- 3. Pin and sew those socks onto the shirt using your marks as guidelines (See Pic 2)
- 4. Calculate the amount of yarn you need to cut for each side (See Pic 3)
- 5. Cut two pieces of yarn in that length.
- 6. Attach one end of the yarn to the sleeve using a sewing machine or needle and thread.
- 7. Measure desired distance to the top stuffed sock and wrap yarn securely around. Then tie (See Pic 4)
- 8. Measure desired distance to the next stuffed sock and wrap yarn securely around. Then tie again and trim off any remaining yarn.
- 9. Repeat steps 6-8 on the other side.
- 10. OPTIONAL: Top with a hat and draw a web on the face.

x=distance between each leg y=distance to wrap and tie yarn securely around the sock legs 2x + 2y + 2"  $\leftarrow$ - this extra 2" is just so you have a bit to spare. EXAMPLE:

I wanted 6 inches between the spider legs, and it also took 6 inches to wrap around and tie the yarn. My formula looked like this:

$$2(6) + 2(6) + 2 = 26$$
