

STAGE AND PROPS

The Little Pig and the Big Bad Wolf Puppet Show



Supplies:

- Table
- 2 Sheets (blue for background, white/tan for table cover)
- White paper for clouds
- Yellow construction paper for sun and Pig #1 house
- Empty cereal box
- Brown construction paper for Pig #2 house
- Markers (yellow, brown and black)
- Glue
- String/Yarn about 24"
- Tape
- Play blocks/bricks
- Log sticks or sticks from outside
- Spaghetti noodles (raw) or long dry grass

STEPS:

1. Set up a table, with a wall about 2 feet behind it.
2. Cover the table with a sheet/tablecloth of any color. We used cream. You could use green, tan, etc...
3. On the wall, hang another sheet/tablecloth. We used blue.
4. Cut out cloud shapes on white scrap paper.
5. Cut out a sunshine on yellow construction paper (or white that is then colored yellow).
6. Tape the sunshine and clouds to the background sheet/tablecloth (see cover photo).
7. Make the 1st and 2nd pigs' home by doing the following:
 - a. Find an empty box (we used an old cereal box).
 - b. Cut off the extra flaps at the top of the box. (The top of the box becomes the bottom of the house, so you want it to sit flat.)
 - c. You don't need to worry about covering the top of the house (the box bottom) because it's a puppet show and the top won't be seen.
 - d. Cover two adjacent sides with yellow paper, and the other two adjacent sides with brown paper (or you could use white paper and just color them with markers).
 - e. Tape a 20-24" string onto the top of the box (see Pic 1)--this will be pulled when the Wolf blows the house down.
 - f. Color yellow stripes on the hay house, and brown and yellow on the stick house (see Pic 2a and Pic 2b).
8. Make the 3rd pig's home by prebuilding a 2 sided structure (see Pic 3).
9. During the play, when talking about the pigs building their homes:
 - a. Pig #1 held up a piece of uncooked spaghetti (see Pic 4a) and then we put up the hay side of the house (and then removed it when it was Pig #2's turn).
 - b. Pig #2 held up a piece play log (see Pic 4b) and then we put up the stick side of the house (and then removed it when it was Pig #3's turn).
 - c. Pig #3 held up a play block (see Pic 4c) and then we put up the prebuilt structure (and then took it down when we continued the story).


