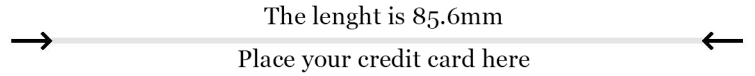


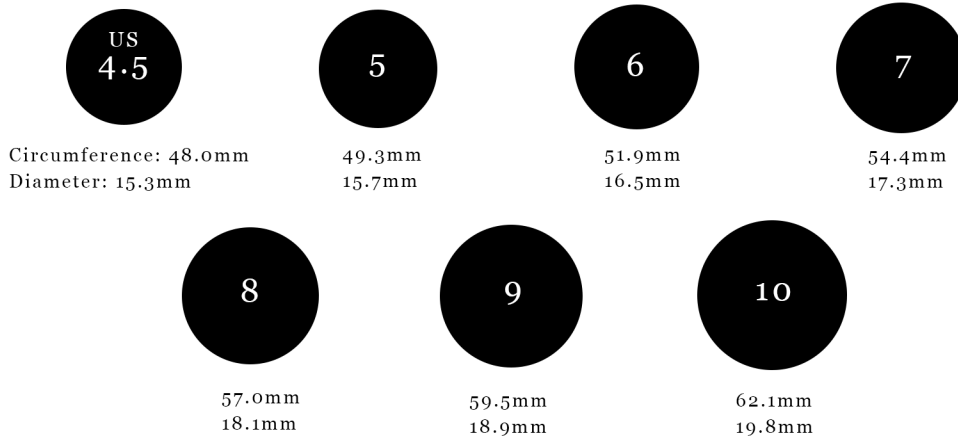
## HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Before printing this guide, make sure that you set to **print at 100% scale** and that you're printing on **standard A4 paper** (210mm x 297mm). If you are unsure that you just printed the correct size, or if you are measuring on a screen, place a credit card on the guide in order to check.



### OPTION 1

The easiest method to find your ring size is to use an existing ring. Simply match the inside of the ring to at least one of the circles below. You should only be able to see the black circle inside your ring and little to no white paper. If your ring fits between two sizes, we tend to recommend taking the larger one.



### OPTION 2

After you cut out the ruler, cut the line to make an opening. Wrap the ruler around your finger with the number visible. The number that seems nearest to the opening is your US ring size. On option 1, you will find to which circumference the US ring size corresponds. Try moving the ruler across your knuckle, we have a tendency to suggest choosing a size that goes on and off your finger easily. Please note, ring size may vary slightly depending on the ring style.
