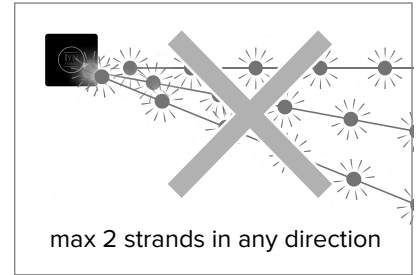
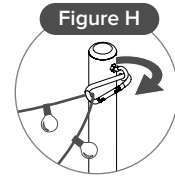


SELECTING MOUNTING LOCATIONS AND STRING LIGHT SETUP

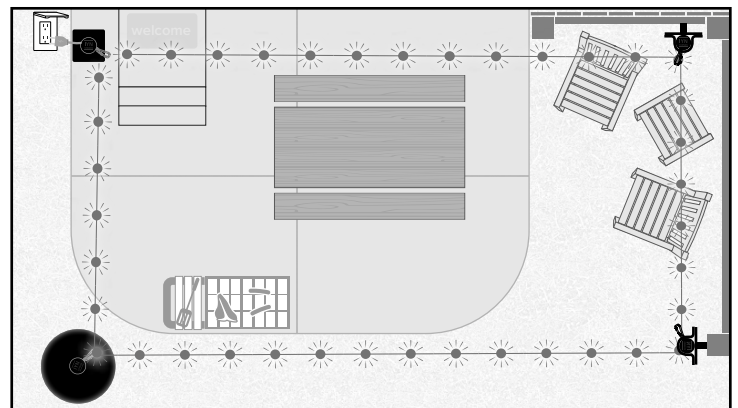
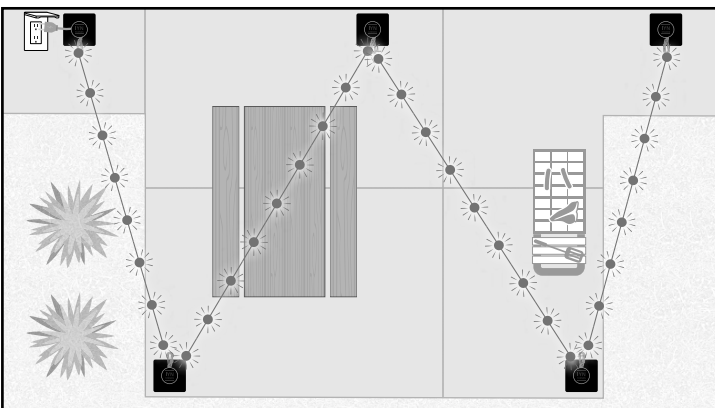
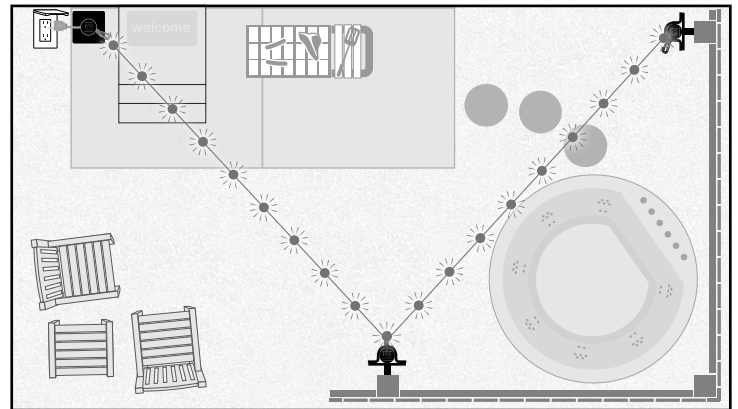
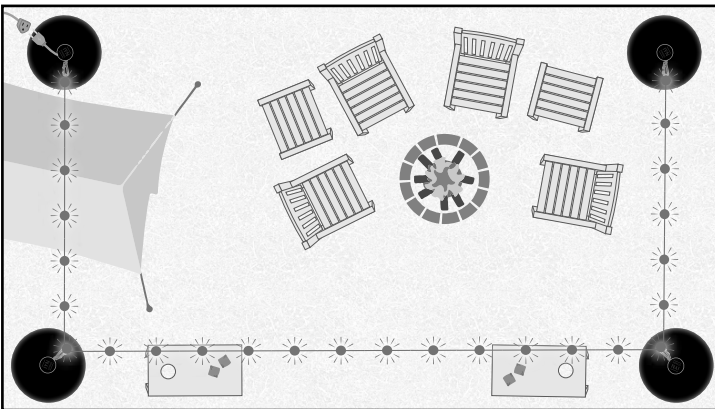

POLE LOCATION(S)

1. Determine if you need access to power. If yes, place a pole near the power source or the female end of your extension cord (use outdoor-rated extension cords when outdoors).
2. Decide what you want lit (such as a table or seating area, along a path or stairs, near food prep, dance floor, hot tub, etc.)
3. Sketch your plan with measurements to determine pole locations and needed string light length. Start with the male end of your string lights at the power source and keep spans between poles ≤ 20 feet for tank stand or ≤ 30 feet for mounting brackets or mounting plate. Because poles assemble by rotation, orient forces clockwise to keep threads tight (see Figure H).
