The PANTS Trial, conducted in a prominent healthcare facility in Perth recently trialed **3 billion CFU** of *Bifidobacterium breve* M-16V in neonates. The trial concluded that the strain was well-tolerated and showed an affinity for colonising the infant's gastrointestinal tract, with detectable elevations of bifidobacteria seen in the treatment group when compared to the placebo group.⁽¹⁾
