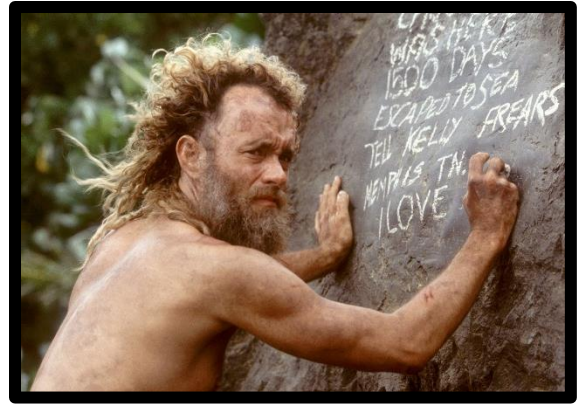




ROBINSON CRUSOE BY DANIEL DEFOE
