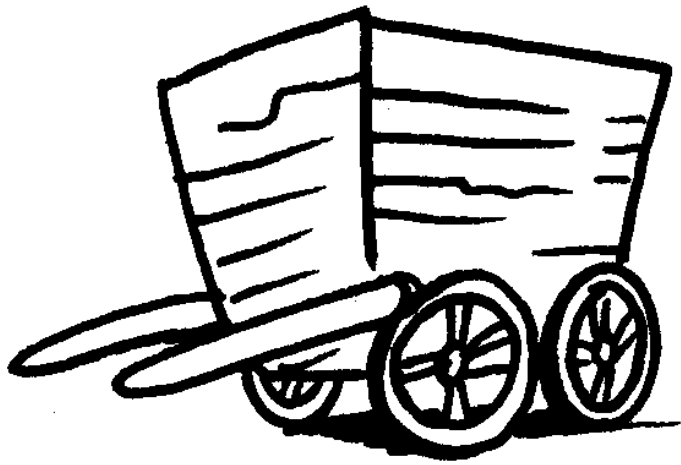
IDIOM: (N) A PHRASE OR EXPRESSION

WHAT THE WORDS ACTUALLY SAY

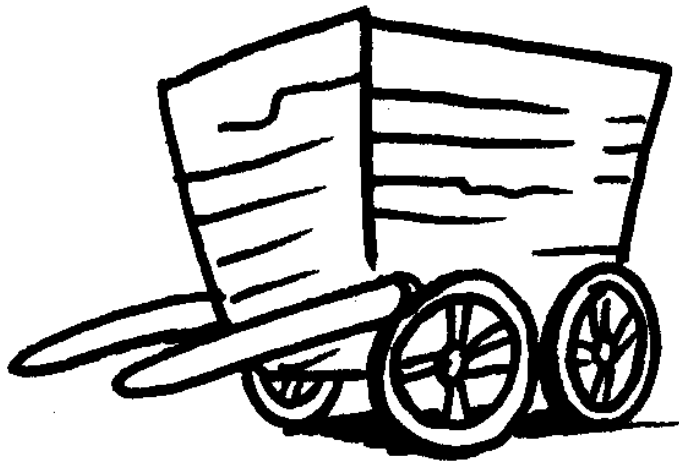
EXAMPLE: SAYING “IT’S OVER HIS
