
# GREEK AND ROMAN MYTHOLOGY COURSE OUTLINE (1 SEMESTER)

Introduction: Have you always wanted to teach a topnotch Greek and Roman mythology course but didn't know where to start? This day-by-day outline will show you exactly how I run my own semester-long Greco-Roman mythology course, which includes units on the Greek gods, Greek heroes, the Trojan War and the Odyssey, and the Roman Aeneid. Scope and Sequence: The course consists of 90 planned days of instruction. Numbers appearing to the left of assignment titles indicate the days of instruction.
