"A" Doll – English/Te Reo Māori

1. Kia ora, my name is "Aa". Ko Aa ahau.
2. What's your name? Ko wai tō ingoa?
3. **We should be friends. Me hoa tāua.**
4. **I like to sing. He pai ki a au te waiata.**
5. Sing the alphabet waiata with me. Tēnā waiatahia mai te waiata arapū ki tōku taha.
6. **SONG: Ahakamana (see separate printable song sheet)**
7. Very good. Ka mutu pea!
8. I love āporo, apples. He rawe ki ahau te āporo. They're reka, yummy.
9. What is your favourite kai? He aha tō tino kai?
10. Let's learn to spell the word Āporo. Say it after me. Whakahuatia mai. Ā...p...o...r...o... Āporo. Pāia! Yay!
11. **SONG: We spelt it (see separate printable song sheet)**
12. My skirt is kōwhai, yellow. He kōwhai tōku panekoti.
13. Kōwhai is my favourite colour, tae. Ko te kōwhai taku tino tae.
14. What's your favourite tae? He aha tō tino tae? Blue, kikorangi? Green, kākāriki? Red, whero? Purple, waipororo? Or yellow, kōwhai?
15. I love to kanikani, dance and waiata, sing. He rawe ki a au te kanikani me te waiata.
16. Let's sing and dance together. Tēnā me waiata me te kanikani tahi tāua.
17. **SONG: Matike Maranga (see separate printable song sheet)**
18. Ka rawe! Awesome!
19. It's fun when we kanikani, waiata and learn together. He pārekareka te kanikani te waiata me tā tāua ako tahi.
