"O" Doll – English/Te Reo Māori

1. Kia ora, my name is Oo. Ko Oo ahau.
2. What's your name? Ko wai koe tō ingoa?
3. Let's have fun and play together. Kia pārekareka tā tātau tākaro tahi.
4. Ahakamana is one of my favourite songs. Ko Ahakamana tētahi o aku tino waiata.
5. Let's waiata, sing and kanikani, dance together. Me waiata me kanikani tahi tāua.
6. **SONG: Ahakamana (see separate printable song sheet)**
7. How are you? Kei te pēhea koe?
8. I feel good. Kei te pai ahau.
9. Kiwi are my special bird friends. Ko ngā manu Kiwi ōku tino hoa.
10. Let's learn how to spell the word kiwi. Tēnā me ako tahi tāua ki te whakahua i te kupu Kiwi. Kiwi...k...i...w...i...Kiwi. Pāia! Yay!
11. **SONG: We spelt it (see separate printable song sheet)**
12. What is your favourite tae, colour? He aha tō tino tae?
13. My favourite colour is whero, red. Ko te whero taku tino tae.
14. My hair, makawe and my dress, panekoti, are whero. He whero ōku makawe me tōku panekoti.
15. It's time to waiata, sing and kanikani, dance. Kua tae te wā ki te waiata ki te kanikani.
16. **SONG: Matike Maranga (see separate printable song sheet)**
17. You're my friend. Ko koe tōku hoa.
18. I love it when we are together. He rawe ki a au te noho tahi.
