"U" Doll – English/Te Reo Māori

1. Kia ora, my name is Uu. Ko Uu ahau.
2. What's your name? Ko wai koe tō ingoa?
3. Would you like to play with me? Kei te pīrangī koe ki te tākaro me au?
4. I love to kanikani, dance. He rawe ki a au te kanikani.
5. Will you kanikani and waiata, sing the alphabet song with me? Ka kanikani ka waiata mai hoki koe i te waiata arapū ki tōku taha?
6. **SONG: Ahakamana (see separate printable song sheet)**
7. Ka pai. That was good
8. Sometimes I feel shy, whakamā. I ētahi wā ka whakamā ahau.
9. How do you feel? Kei te pēhea koe?
10. I'm wearing a kākārīki, green, piupiu. Kei te mau ahau i tētahi piupiu kākārīki.
11. Kākārīki is my favourite tae, colour. Ko te kākārīki taku tino tae.
12. What is your favourite tae? He aha tō tino tae?
13. I like to play with my pōro, ball. He pai ki a au te tākaro me taku pōro.
14. Do you have a pōro? He pōro tāu?
15. Let's learn to spell the word pōro. Me ako tāua ki te whakahua i te kupu pōro... p...ō...r...o...Pōro! Pāia! Yay!
16. **SONG: We spelt it (see separate printable song sheet)**
17. Ka rawe! Excellent!
18. I love to count. He rawe te tatau ki ahau.
19. Let's count together. Me tatau tahi tāua: 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10. Pāia. Yay!
20. Get ready to waiata and kanikani. Kia rite ki te waiata me te kanikani!
21. **SONG: Matike Maranga (see separate printable song sheet)**
22. Mīharo! Fantastic. Let's play again. Me tākaro anō tāua.
