

Erin's All-Purpose Horse Blanket & Net Wash

Springtime is finally upon us! Do you have a pile of stinky blankets and nets? Here's an easy and non-toxic soap recipe to make that will clean them right up.

SERVES: Every stinky blanket and net on the place!

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 c Washing soda
(available at Walmart, or substitute with baking soda)
- 2 c Bar soap, grated
(or order from puresoapflakes.com)
- 2 Tbs Peppermint essential oil
(or extract) The peppermint oil will help
keep the rodents away, and give it a fresh smell!

DIRECTIONS:

1. Mix all ingredients together very well and store in an airtight container.
2. Fill an old water trough half-way with cold water.
3. Add 1-2 cups of the mixture and stir well.
4. Add blankets or nets and stir well. Soak for 20-30 minutes.
5. You may have to stir again or use a stiff bristle brush to remove stubborn stains.
6. Remove from water and rinse well. Hang on a fence line until dry.

If you have access to a commercial washer, you can machine wash both your blankets and nets. Add approximately 1 cup of the mix to every large load.
