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# Trailer Maintenance Checklist

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- DE-WINTERIZE WATER AND SEWER
  - CHECK PROPANE LEVELS AND PURGE THE SYSTEM
  - MAKE SURE TIRES ARE FILLED TO THE CORRECT PSI, EVEN THE SPARE.  
(FOUND ON THE SIDE OF THE TIRE ITSELF)
  - CHECK FOR CRACKS IN THE TIRE (A SIGN OF DRY ROT)
  - CHECK LUG NUTS TO ENSURE THEY ARE TIGHT
  - CHECK WHEEL BEARINGS AND BREAKS (BEARINGS SHOULD BE PACKED EVERY  
COUPLE OF YEARS, USUALLY REQUIRES A PROFESSIONAL)
  - CHECK THE CHARGE ON THE BREAKAWAY BATTERY
  - GREASE TRAILER JACK AND TRUCK HITCH
  - MAKE SURE BATTERIES ARE CHARGED
  - MAKE SURE ALL LIGHTS ARE WORKING
  - CHECK TO MAKE SURE THERE ARE NO WASPS, BEES, OR BIRDS MAKING YOUR  
TRAILER A HOME.
  - CHECK ALL LATCHES, HINGES, BOLTS, AND SAFETY CHAINS
  - IF YOU HAVE A RAMP, CHECK THE STABILITY
  - LIFT TRAILER MATS TO CHECK THE CONDITION OF THE FLOOR  
(CHECK ALUMINUM FOR SIGNS OF CORROSION & WOOD FOR SIGNS OF CRUMBLING)
  - CHECK THE SUPPORTS UNDERNEATH TO MAKE SURE THEY ARE IN GOOD CONDITION
  - DEEP CLEAN: LIVING QUARTERS, HORSE QUARTERS, AND TACK
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
