

HAY RACK INSTALLATION

Hay Rack Capacity:


Half Bale size holds up to 1/2 of a small hay bale Full bale size holds a full square hay bale



Tools Needed for Installation: drill, screwdriver or screwdriver drill bit, tape measure *Note: Heavy duty wood screws require a T25 star bit.* 1. Open the threaded locking nut and weave net onto frame starting with the seam so you end up with seam on the back of the frame. Turn threaded locking nut to close opening.



2. Position Hay Rack in preferred corner at desired height so horse cannot eat over the top of the frame. (If your horse is shod hang it high enough so your horse cannot paw at the net.) The empty net should hang ideally at chest height. Place 2 yokes on each side of the frame and secure with included screws. You are done! Toss in your hay & walk away!
