CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Love the feel, feel the love and treat with love...

Please follow our care guide to help keep your Original Alpaca Liner ™ and other Alpaca products as soft and snuggly as the day you first fell in love with their feel. Day-to-day care couldn't be easier, dirt and grime disperses with a little TLC and a thorough brushing.

We recommend you use a wire pet brush or sheepskin brush to maintain the condition of the fur, which will give it a good old fluffing up.

Little ones can have lots of spillages and messy incidents so for these mishaps please try this tip from our very experienced manufacturers:

"Cover the affected area with talcum powder (we love the safe and talc free version from Bamford) and gently but deeply rub in. Leave for an hour or two, then brush away the excess. This will lift residues and dirt from the hair shaft and restore the fluffiness of the fur."

Alternatively spot clean with baby shampoo and dry off any access dampness with a towel then continue to air dry naturally, if adding heat from a radiator or Aga do this with care and at a low temperature as overheating can cause damage and stiffness.

Once completely dry give it a good old fluffing up with your brush.

As infrequently as possible you may wish to machine wash your Original Alpaca Liner ™ please do this on a hand wash wool cycle under 30 degrees and use a specialist wool wash which will be kind to the delicate natural fibres.

In trials we successfully (washed) and tumbled dried our Liners on a gentle cycle for short amounts times and kept checking them. The results were even softer and fluffier than before.*

Alternatively you may wish to enlist the professionals and handover your much loved item to your trusted dry cleaning specialists.
