CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Love the feel, feel the love and treat with love...

The Little Finery Cashmere is the finest yarn to wrap around your loved ones or yourself. With a little TLC these investment pieces will fill your heart for years to come. Please follow our care guide to help keep your cashmere as soft and snuggly as the day you first fell in love with its feel.

Pilling is expected with any cashmere garment and isn't a reflection of the quality or the gauge. Should pilling or a little bobbles occur on your item simply remove by hand or by using a specialist cashmere comb or cashmere shaver.

Cashmere comes from the underlay of a goat's coat, the natural fibres like human hair actually become softer after washing so by following our care tips we hope you feel confident with this process.

Cashmere has natural antibacterial properties and can be worn a good few times before needing a proper wash. In between washes spot cleaning with mild detergent or specialist wool wash should suffice.

Hand wash with a mild detergent or specialist wool wash by adding the recommended quantities to a basin of cold or just slightly warm water and let your item soak for up to 10 minutes then gently wash through until the water is clear. Hot water can shrink cashmere very quickly so do be careful. Regular bio washing detergent, stain removers and regular softener will NOT be suitable for your cashmere.

Machine washing cashmere is not for the faint hearted but I have successfully and occasionally popped mine in the machine on the wool cycle and inside a laundry bag or pillow case and all has been well. All machines are different so please do this at your own risk. You may also specialist dry clean.

STORAGE TIP

Keep your The Little Finery gift boxes to store your cashmere pieces, wrap in tissue paper with cedar balls which will deter moths and your cashmere will keep in beautiful condition for years to come
