


Christmas Tree Math CRAFT PROJECT


Christmas Tree Math is a perfect activity for fall afternoons when your students need a change of pace! The pages can be mixed and matched to differentiate according to your students' needs. Blank templates are also included if you want to skip the math and do only the craft.

Materials Needed


- Copies of tree template
- Green colored paper (light green AstroBrite is great)
- Glue or stapler
- Scissors
- Colored pom poms or bingo markers or colored dot stickers or cotton balls, or crayons
- Star toothpicks





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

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STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Decide which combination of math facts pages to use and gather supplies.

2. Decorate the trees with stickers, bingo markers, pom-poms, or other colorful materials.

3. Complete the math problems on each sheet.

4. Cut out the tree shapes.

5. Fold each cut-out tree shape down the middle, with the printed side in the fold.

6. Apply glue to one side of the first tree and glue it back to back to the next one.

To avoid the mess of glue, the pages can be stapled together instead. Before folding tree shapes, lay them flat back to back, then staple down the middle with the stem in the middle. Then fold the whole bunch down the middle and hammer out the pages to create the 3D tree shape.

Continue gluing the shapes together. When you reach the last shape add the tree hangers or stickers to the top to complete the tree!
