STEP 1

Print out your pattern. You can size it (change the scaling) according to your pumpkin.

STEP 2


Get out your pumpkin carving kit. Remove the pumpkin guts! OR - just clean your pumpkin if you plan to draw the pattern vs carve it.

STEP 3

Cut around the pattern and tape it onto your pumpkin.

STFP 4

If you are carving the pumpkin, mark your pattern edge using a push pin or the "pokey radial tool". If drawing it, use a ball point pen to mark the edge. Press HARD - you want to create an indent in the pumpkin. Then pull off the pattern.



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
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
