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Rebirth in SELF.

Jesus said, "To enter the Kingdom of Heaven you have to be reborn in the Spirit". He also said, "I am the way, and through me you will enter the Kingdom of Heaven".

Unfortunately, there are many different Christian cults that take this statement literally, as they do with many other teachings in the Gospels. They kneel and pray to Jesus, and in a moment of fervour devote their life to Jesus, and then go out and tell the world: "Praise the Lord! I am reborn again in Jesus." But they never follow Jesus and do as he taught, but only follow Jesus intellectually, in a prideful way.

Being reborn in the Spirit, or SELF, involves many years of effort and is not something to be achieved by making a quick decision. People are misled into believing rebirth in Light is somewhat instantaneous, and base this on information they have read somewhere, such as the conversion of the Disciple Paul, who, at one instance was murdering the Christians and in the next moment was struck down and had a revelation that changed his life, and then immediately began teaching inner knowledge previously unknown to him.

It is important that when a Trustee studies the scriptural works of any religion they must possess the acuteness and understanding that will reveal those inferences which the translator either added or changed to suit the church rulers.

I am going to set out here the steps to be followed by everyone who is seeking to reach the state of enlightenment and oneness with the highest part of their being, which is SELF. These steps are not usually attained in one particular Life-experience, but generally build up over a series of recurrent lives.

Whereas one person may achieve the full rebirth in one Life-experience, the steps leading to this oneness have been gradually attained by experiencing previous life recurrences.

We need to understand that this is not a new journey, but a return journey to what we actually are and have lost. If you read the parable of the prodigal son in the Gospels, you will see that the young man left his father's house and went deeper into the lusts of the senses and Illusion, eventually realising

all this was nothing to what he truly possessed in his father's house, and so began the return journey.

All of us have strayed from our father's house into the Illusion and drawn into a life based on sensual knowledge and enjoyment. We have sunk so deep into the darkness and ignorance of this world, that we no longer have any contact with the true reality of our life. We believe this body and Personality represents our SELF, and because of this realisation we believe we are self-conscious.

So how can anyone, who believes they are conscious and have a SELF, become aware that they are not conscious and are asleep to the reality of their True SELF? If you point this out to others, they will look at you as if you have lost your marbles and shake their head.

At this stage of being, these individuals are totally unprepared to enter the journey home and still have many desires and identifications with the outer world, which runs on vanity, covetousness, greed and control. Their time is not right.

The majority of people are driven, herd-like, by the Illusion. They are asleep, and mechanically respond to everything they are taught.
