Feature I

There are 28 types of collagen in our body. The key ingredient of our cream is Type I collagen, which structures and rebuilds skin tissues.

Feature II

Our collagen cream forms a nano-sized water membrane to facilitate the dermal delivery of low-molecular collagen (> 500 Daltons). The membrane collects the collagen and makes them get through the epidermis. (*Patented in 2015*)

Feature III

Further, chitosan and alginic acid - natural ingredients - form a film barrier to enhance collagen absorption into the skin. (*Patent Pending*)

Many companies try adopting film-forming technology into mask products. Our collagen cream, however, is fundamentally different from such products made with synthetic resins. While those products may irritate and damage the skin when taking off the film, ours leaves a natural glow and rich, glossy feel.

< Human Body Application Test Report >

A clinical study designed to evaluate the 24-Hour skin radiance (gloss) effect of T1 Collagen 100.

Subjects: 22 females aged between 30 and 60

Test Result:

1. Compared to before using the testing substance, the skin gloss increased by 36.53% immediately after one use and 29.66% after 24 hours, indicating the 24-hour lasting effect of skin radiance.
2. No adverse skin reactions were observed during the clinical test.

Conclusion:

The product helps to maintain skin radiance for 24 hours.

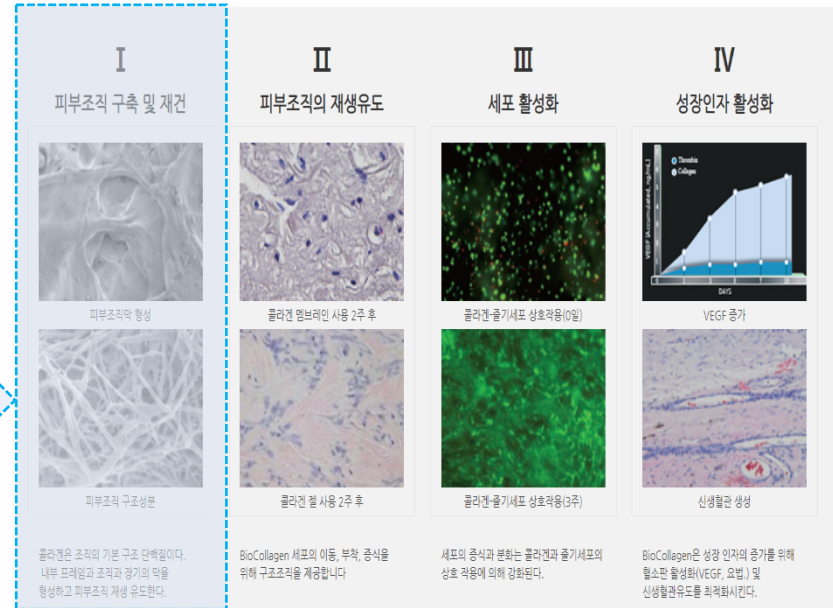
Among 28 types of collagens, the representative collagens are 1, 2, 3, and 4!

Also, we applied TDS (Transdermal Delivery System) and ODT (Occlusive Dressing Technique) to the product to effectively deliver collagen and other active ingredients deep into the skin without physical or chemical irritation.

Fill in the creases with hydrolyzed collagen cream! Our innovative cream forms a film to effectively deliver collagen peptides into our skin, gradually improving the skin texture and reducing signs of aging over time. Plus, vitamins and anti-oxidant botanicals balance and polish the skin all the more. Use it anywhere at any time and add a youthful glow to your skin!

HOW TO USE

● Cleanse your face and apply toner to balance the skin. ● Apply the product to the area of concern using a spatula (6 to 7g for entire face and lesser for targeted area). You can also use hands ● A film will form as active ingredients absorb. Peel off the film once it dries clear. ● Gently pat in any remaining essence. Follow up with facial massage if desired.

* The film formation rate varies depending on skin type or humidity.

* You can apply the product before going to bed.

PRECAUTIONS

● Stop using the product and consult a dermatologist or physician if the following occurs: (a) Swelling, red (strawberry) marks, or other abnormalities; (b) Itchiness due to indirect or direct exposure to light. ● Do not apply to open wounds, eczema, or dermatitis. ● Prior to general use, test on your skin for sensitivity. ● Avoid contact with eyes. If contact occurs, flush eyes thoroughly with clean water.

STORAGE & HANDLING MEASURES

● Use only as directed. ● Keep the cap closed when not in use. ● Keep the product out of the reach of children. ● Keep out of the heat or direct sunlight.

Q. How often should I be using the product?

A. We recommend using the product 2 to 3 times a week, but you can use it daily.

Q. What is the recommended amount per treatment?

A. Approx. 6 to 7g can cover the entire face. That's about the size of 2 quarters. Use lesser if you are applying to a targeted area.

Q. Do I have to use spatula?

A. You can use your hands, but spatula helps to spread the cream evenly on the curved area.

Q. Can I use basic skincare products before applying the product?

A. No, please use facial toners only. Lotions and creams can interfere with collagen absorption and film formation.

Q. Should I wash my face afterward?

A. No. The film can be easily removed from the face without washing your face. Once you remove the film, gently pat in any remaining essence.

Q. Should I continue onto my regular skin care routine after taking off the film?

A. No, you don't have to. Your skin will remain hydrated and nourished.

Q. What is the Type I collagen?

A. There are 28 types of collagen in our body. Type I collagen is most commonly found, especially in our skin, and it structures and rebuilds skin tissues. Dermatologists and dentists often use type I collagen to promote wound healing.

Q. Should I use the product in the morning or at night?

A. You can use it at any time.

Q. Can I put on makeup after applying the product?

A. Before putting on makeup, make sure to completely remove the film formed from the cream.

Q. Can I exercise or sleep with the product applied?

A. Yes. Feel free to exercise or sleep once the film forms. Before the film formation, however, the product may smear against clothes or pillows.
