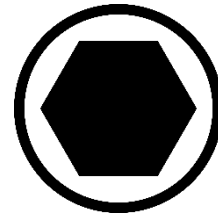

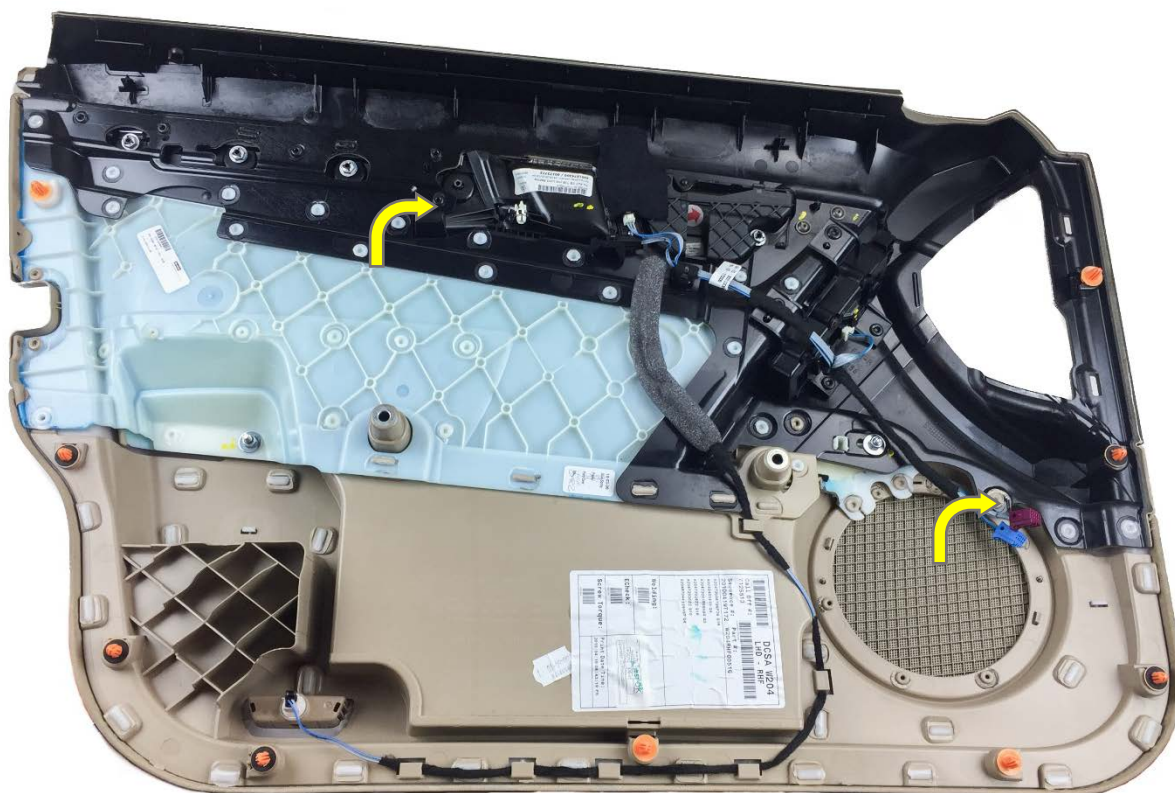

## Step 1: Remove the inside panel from the door.

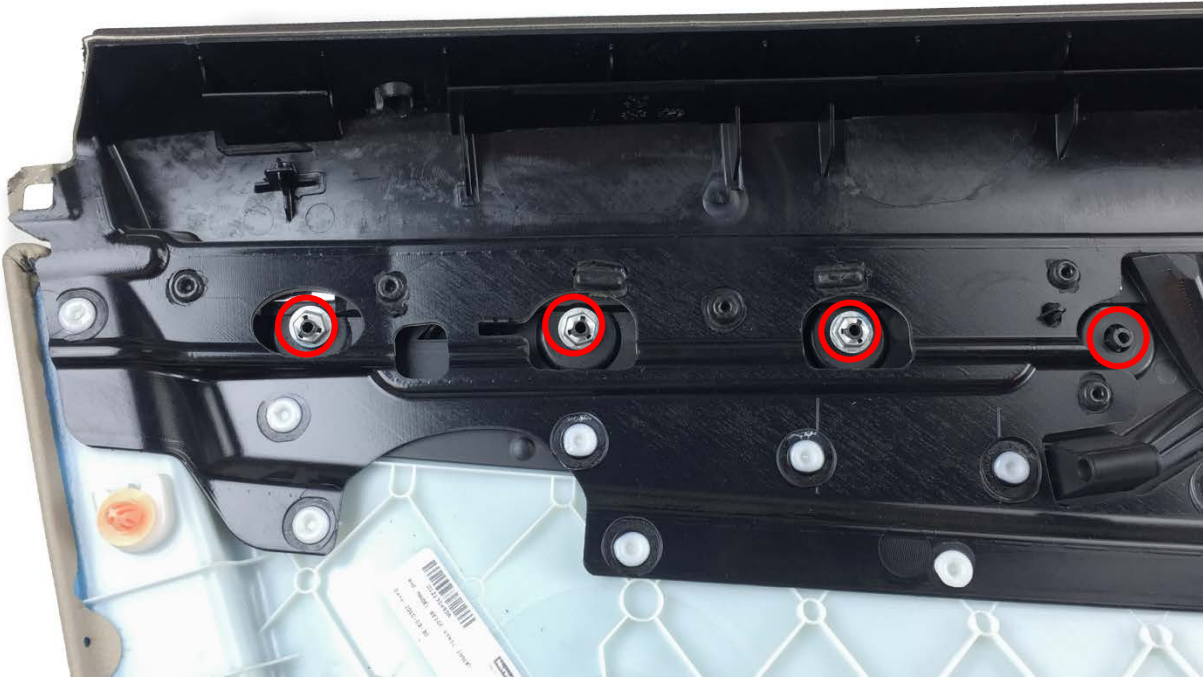


-  Two T30 Torx screws.
-  One T30 Torx screw is located behind the pillar cover.
-  Remove the triangular speaker and the cover.  
Pry out the orange clips located near the outside of panel.
-  Slide the door lock through the hole.
-  Disconnect the cable from the panel's cable holder.  
Disconnect the two wire connections.

**Tips:** Lower the window for an easier access.



## Step 2: Remove the wood trims.



○ Unbolt Five M10 Caps. Carefully push the two wood trims out.

**Step 3:** Separate the handle bracket from the door panel.



The handle bracket and the door panel are held together by melted plastic tabs.



- Use cutting pliers to remove the heads of the melted tabs.
- Two T10 Torx Screws.





→ Disconnect the LED and lock button wire harness.











**Step 4:** Remove the handle pivoting pin.




- To remove the pin, carefully drive a screw into it. This will allow you to pull it out with your hands. Use the provided new pin for assembly.

## Step 5: Assembly



→ Transfer the cable clip onto the new handle.



 Using the 20 provided screws, fasten the door panel to the handle bracket where the plastic tabs were located.
