





# Materials and Equipment list - River Wey Watermill

### **PAPER**

For most of my paintings I have used Bockingford 140lb / 300gm Rough surface paper. The paper size for all of the projects is ¼ imperial, 11ins x 15ins

### **PAINTS**

Use the best quality paint you can afford, it's well worth paying the extra for Artists' quality. I use Daler Rowney 15ml tube paints.

Here is a list of the colours I use in this painting.

- Ultramarine

# **TERRY'S PALETTE**

My palette has a clip on lid that helps keep the paint from drying out and 3 separate mixing areas to keep the colours fresh.

## **MASKING FLUID**

This is used to mask off detail you want to retain white. You will need an old brush to apply the masking fluid.

# PENS, PENCILS & OTHER TOOLS

A 2B pencil is the best for sketching and drawing. Ruling Pen Wipe Away Tool

# **MASKING TAPE**

I use masking tape to fix the paper to my drawing board.

# **BRUSHES**
