Step 1

Let's remove the grille assembly. Start with removing the push pins on the plastic cover inside the engine bay



Step 2

Remove the six 10mm bolts from the top of the grill assembly



Step 3

Remove the ten 10mm bolts and 2 push pins to remove the top brow portion of the grille.



Step 4

Unclip the trim piece under the headlights and remove 2 10mm bolts from each side.





Step 5

Now loosen up the bottom brow portion of the grill. For this step you can get under the vehicle and look for 3 bolts that need to be removed. Once the bolts are removed just pull on the brow to unclip it from the grille.



Step 6

The last thing that holds the grille in place are three 10mm bolts on each side.



Step 7

You can remove the front grille assembly and set it aside.



Step 8

Note the bolt which we are going to be using to install the mounts. You will not need to remove the bumper bolt



compeltely. Just loosen it enough to slide the brackets into and tighten it back up. You will need to trim the rubber to make it leveled flat as shown by the red line in the photo.

Here is the photo of installed driver side bracket. Do the same for the passenger side.



Step 9

Now that we have the driver and passenger brackets installed, its time to install the lightbar. Use the provided one washer and one bolt for each side to install the light bar.



Step 10

Follow the reverse grill removal process to put everything back together and do the wiring. The light bar has 6ft of wiring with a red (positive) and a black negative cable coming out of them. Please purchase a separate wiring harness or make your own in order to power the light bar.
