Pocket Book Making with Fibre Books

In the session Lucy will go through some initial principles of bookbinding, how to use subject specific tools and of course the binding technique. Workshop participants leave with an 80-page hardback pocketbook with deckled edges and a front cover label. You may like to bring along an apron as there will be the use of glue but this will be water soluble. There will be some use of sharp tools

Lucy Farren is an independent bookbinder and box-maker based in Newcastle. Originally from Durham, she discovered a love of bookbinding while studying Illustration in London. She brought her craft back to the North East and set up a small business called FibreBooks. Lucy makes high-quality, slow-made books and teaches the skills in workshops using beautiful materials and traditional tools.
