Using the potters wheel - learn to throw and turn a shallow bowl in stoneware. The bowl will then be taken away to be glazed and fired and will be ready to collect back at the gallery at an arranged time.

[Kirsty Adams](#) is an award-winning ceramicist, making for over twenty years. She originally trained at Brighton Art College and then on the potters' wheel in Japan. She has developed a personal approach to throwing on the wheel using porcelain clay, to produce unique pieces for the home. Having originally set up a studio in London, she now works from her studio in Newcastle upon Tyne.
