

SPRAYER WINTERIZATION

For Kings Sprayers & Other Brands

Your equipment will “fare” better with the **F.A.R.E.S.** method.

FLUSH

Flush the entire system, including the tank, spray gun, boom, with clean water to remove chemical residue. If harsher chemicals were used in the sprayer, a neutralizer is recommended.

ANTIFREEZE

To further protect the system from freezing temperatures, pump a 50/50 mix of antifreeze and water throughout the system at low pressure. Allow the antifreeze mixture to fill up and replace any water in hoses and booms.

REMOVE COMPONENTS

Remove and store any ancillary components such as spray guns, nozzles, strainers. Ensure components are clean and dry and store in a place where they will remain clean and dry.

EMPTY GAS TANK

For sprayers with gas-powered engines, slide the gas feed on the engine to the OFF position, and run the unit until it shuts off.

STABILIZE

Add a gas stabilizer to the fuel tank.

- Anyone whose equipment will sit idle for 2 or more months.
