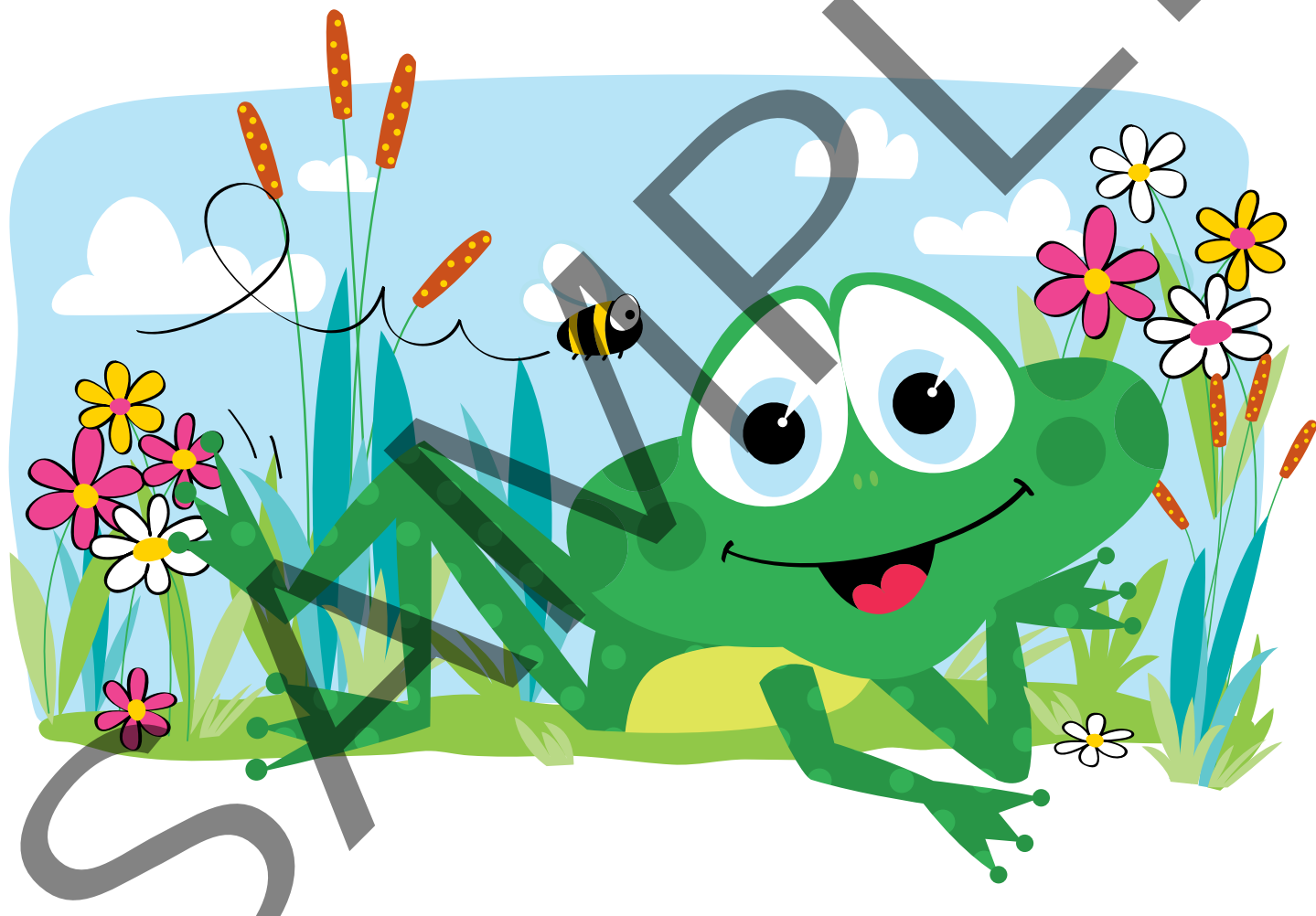
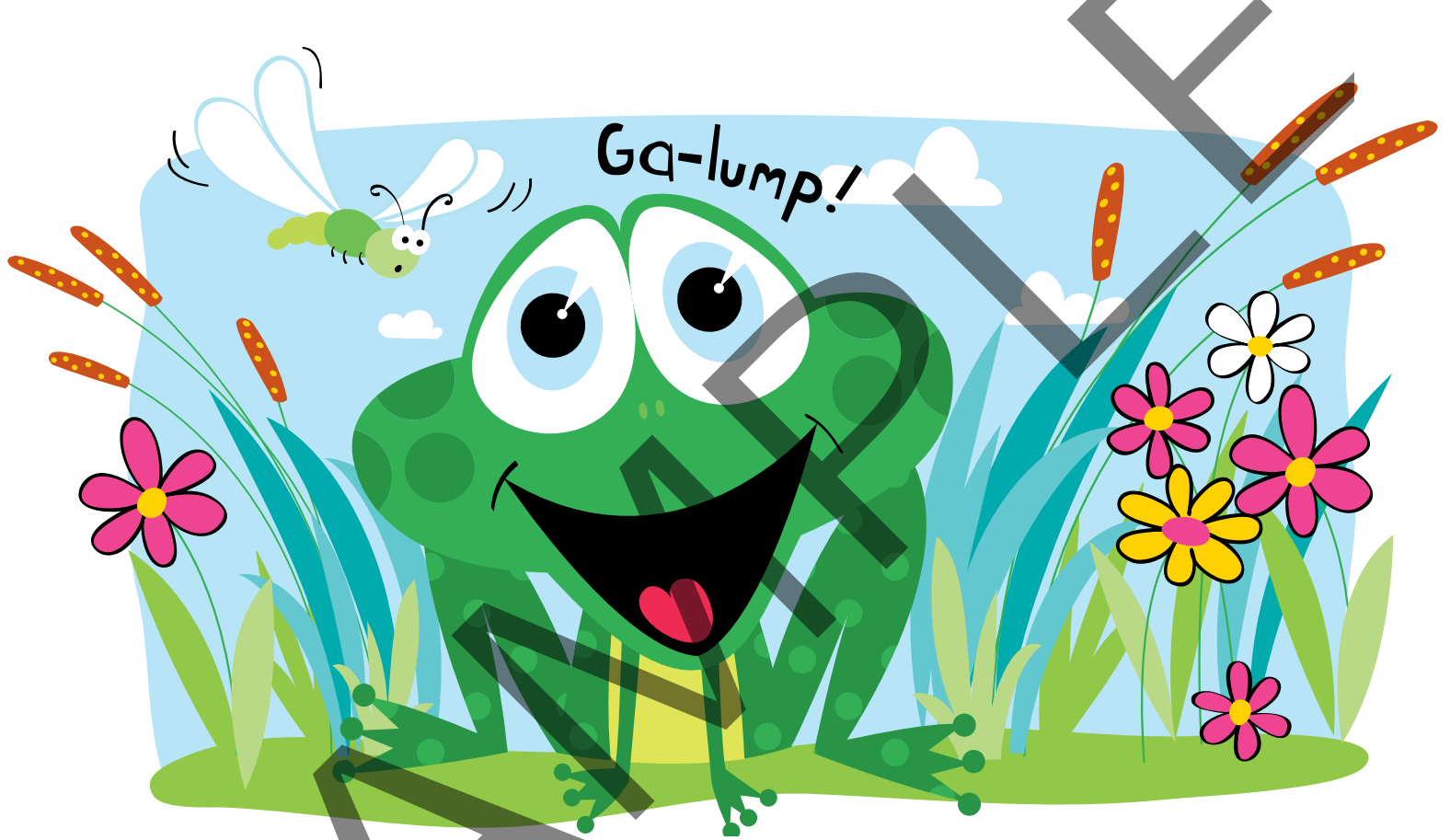


Little Green Frog
