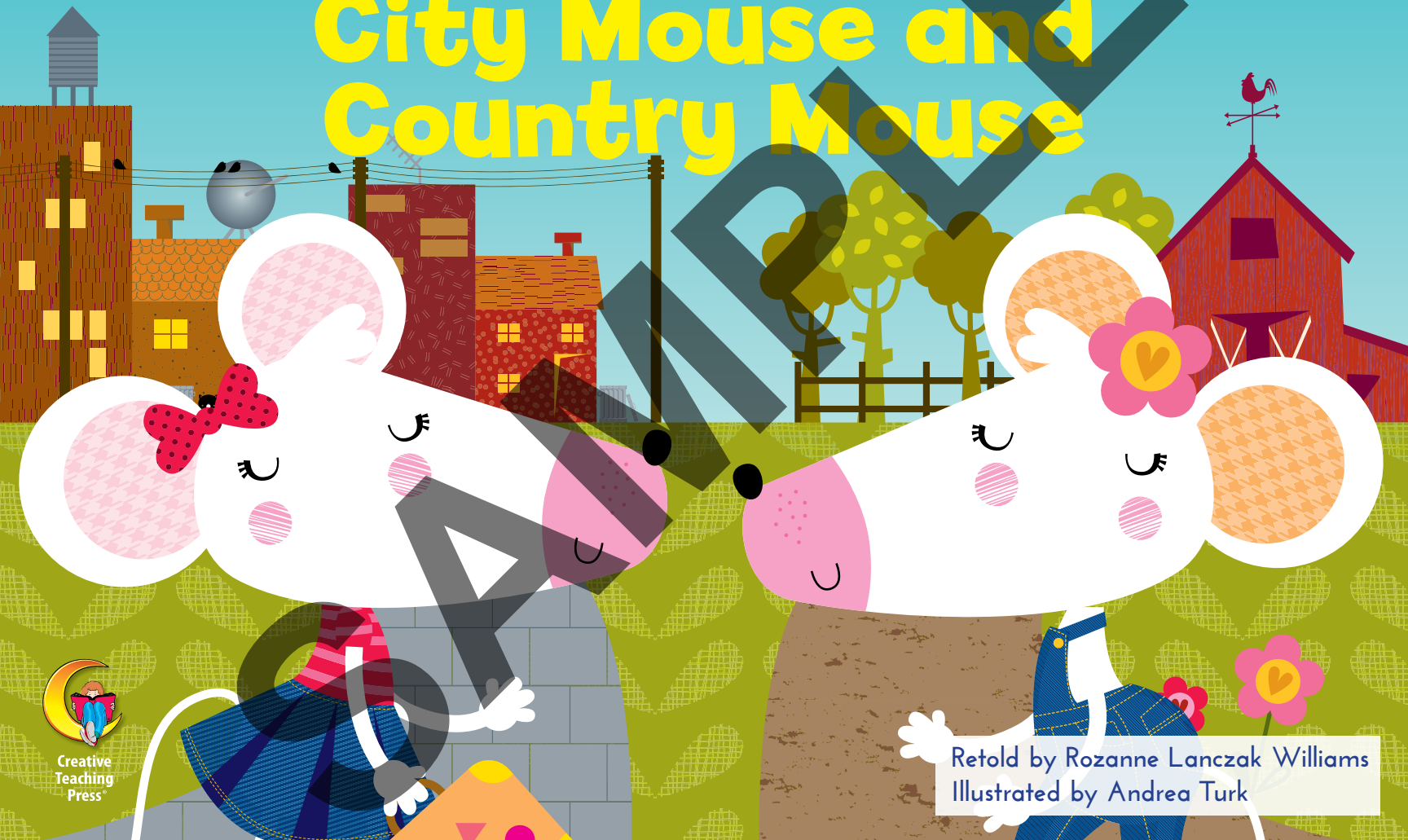


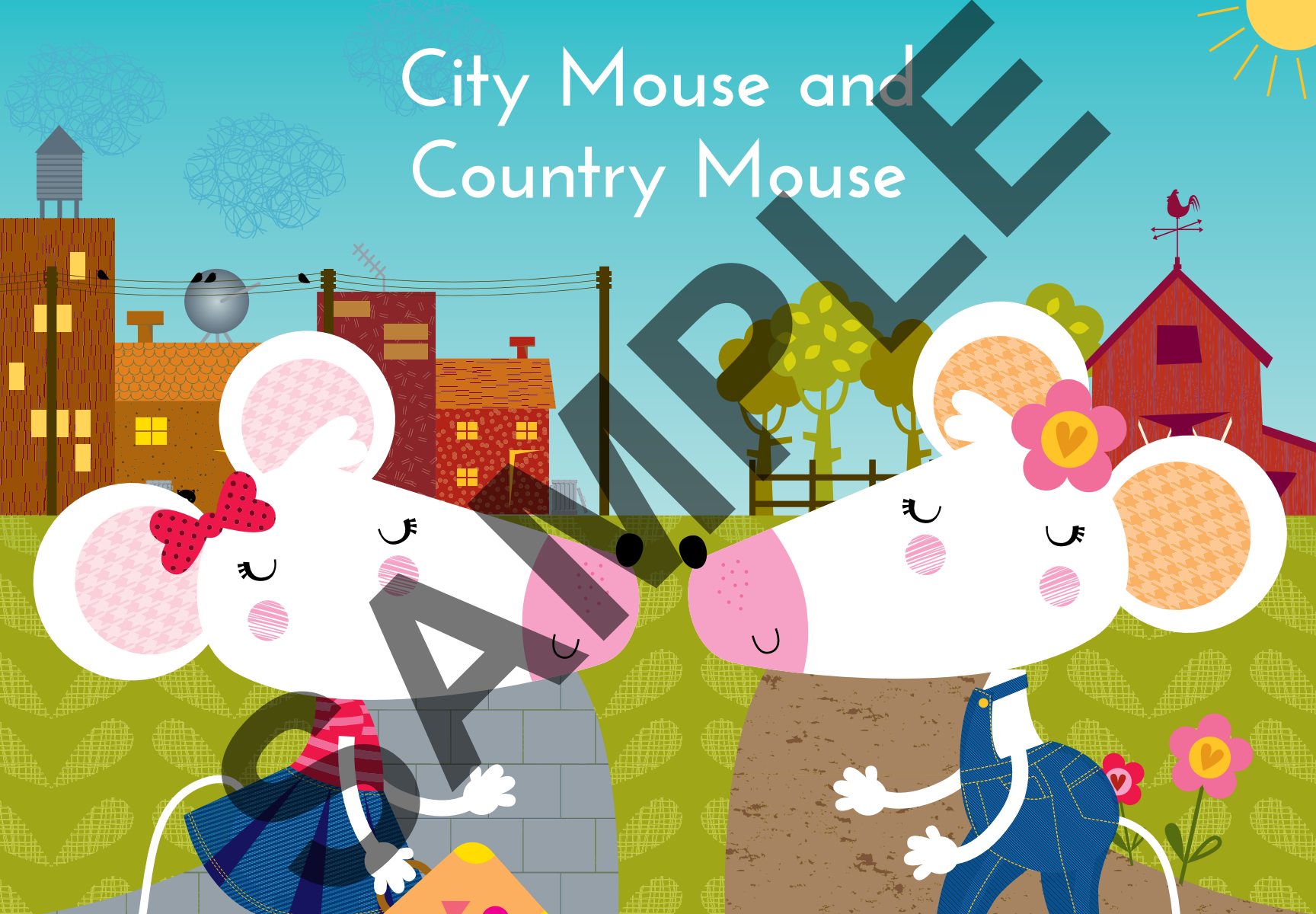

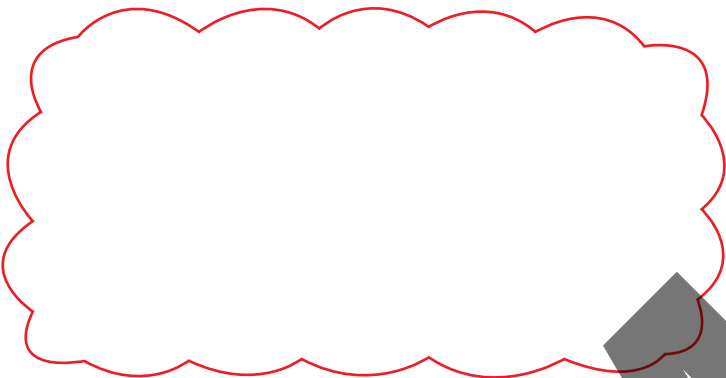
# City Mouse and Country Mouse

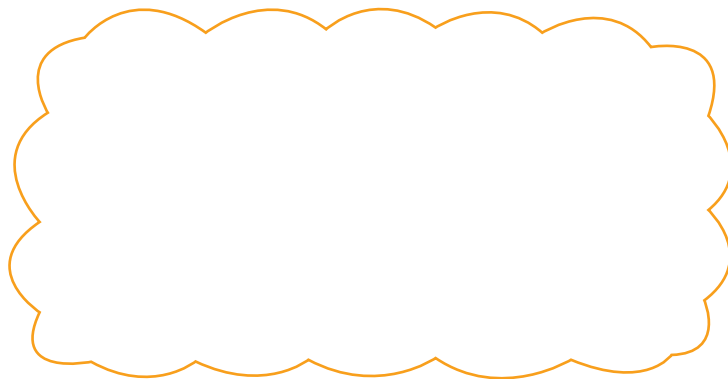
