Q1: Let's look at the cover and read the title. What do you see in the picture? A1: I see lots of funny monsters waiting in line for the Airplane Ride. A few monsters are buying tickets. There are many safety rules to read. Q2: Why are safety rules important? (Why does safety count?) A2: Safety rules are important so that no one gets hurt. Rules keep everyone safe.	Q1: On the title page, we see the monsters on the Airplane Ride. Are the monsters following the safety rules? A1: Yes, the monsters are following the safety rules. They are keeping their hands inside. They are not standing up. No one is wearing glasses. All the monsters are tall enough. Q2: What are some ways that the monsters are being safe? A2: Possible answers: One monster is holding the ladder so that her friend does not fall. In the kitchen, the little monster is standing back from the hot oven. The monsters are riding bikes on the sidewalk and wearing helmets.	Q1: What safety rules are important at the park and at the swimming pool? A1: At the park: Wear shoes. Ride your bike on the bike path. Stay with a friend. Be careful near the swings. At the swimming pool: Walk! Listen to the lifeguard. No diving. Wear sunscreen. Q2: What other safety rules do you know and follow? A2: Possible answers: Walk, don't ride your bike across the street. Look in all directions before you cross the street. Don't play with matches. Do not swim alone.
