<p>Q1: Let's look at the cover and read the title. What are Cat and Dog doing in the picture?</p> <p>A1: Cat is holding a holding some lollipops. Dog is looking through a magnifying glass. Cat is pointing and looking at a cookie.</p> <p>Q2: What do you think Cat and Dog will do?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: I think Cat and Dog will do science experiments. They will use the magnifying glass, the lollipops, and the cookies. I think Cat and Dog will look at things, like the bug and the plant, through the magnifying glass.</p>	<p>Q1: What happened to the water that Dog put in the freezer?</p> <p>A1: The water froze. It became ice. Then it melted again when Cat put the ice in the sun. Under the hot sun, the water evaporated.</p> <p>Q2: What did Cat do with the sugar and then the lollipops?</p> <p>A2: Cat put sugar in the water. The sugar dissolved. Cat put lollipops in the water. The lollipops dissolved in the water too.</p>	<p>Q1: What happened to Dog's cookies? Did the cookies freeze, melt, dissolve, or evaporate?</p> <p>A1: No, Cat ate the cookies!</p> <p>Q2: How do you know?</p> <p>A2: I know that Cat ate the cookies because I see the crumbs. The crumbs are all over Cat.</p>
