It got hot, so Mom got a new tan fan.



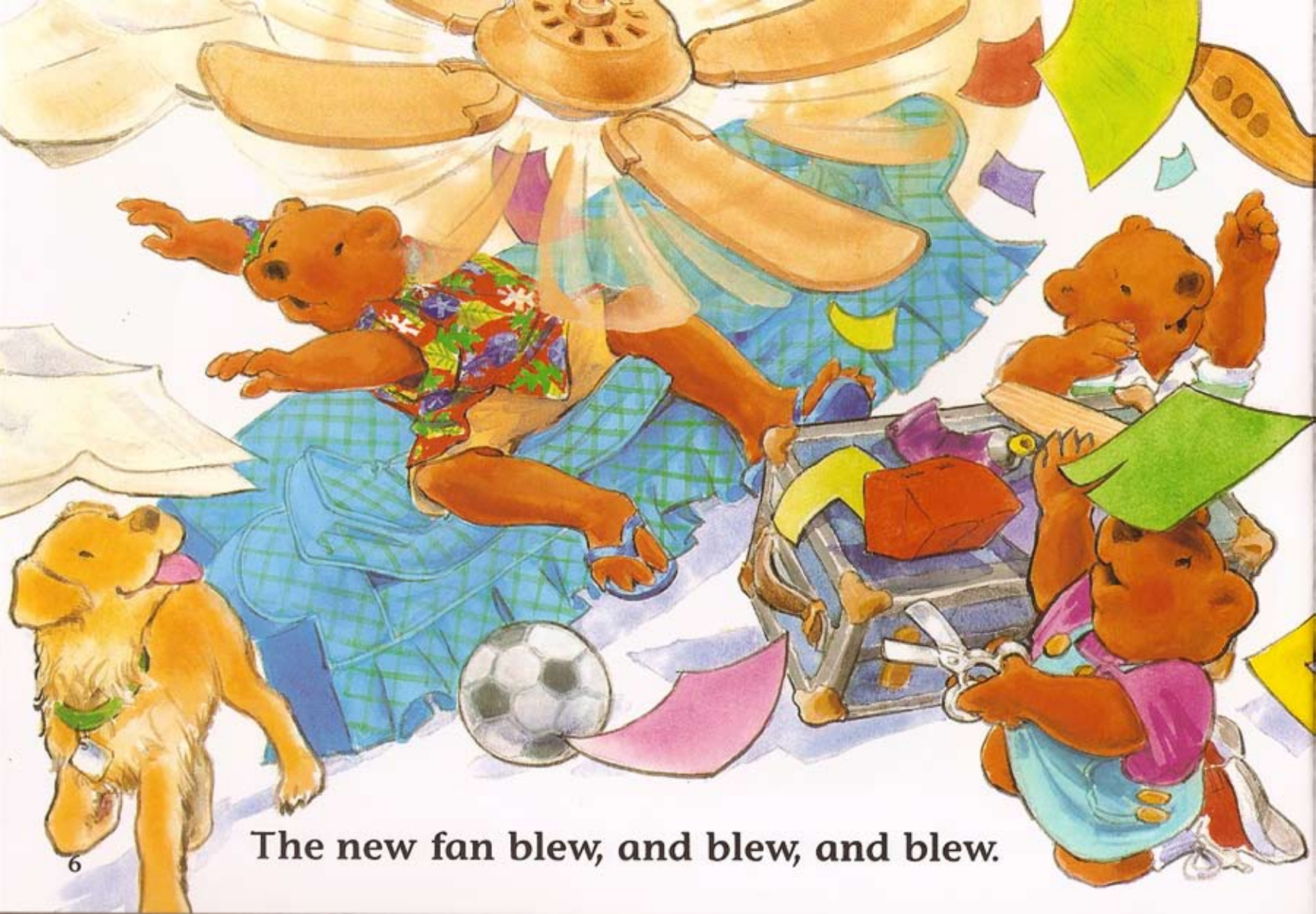
"Mom," said Tom, "it is hot!"



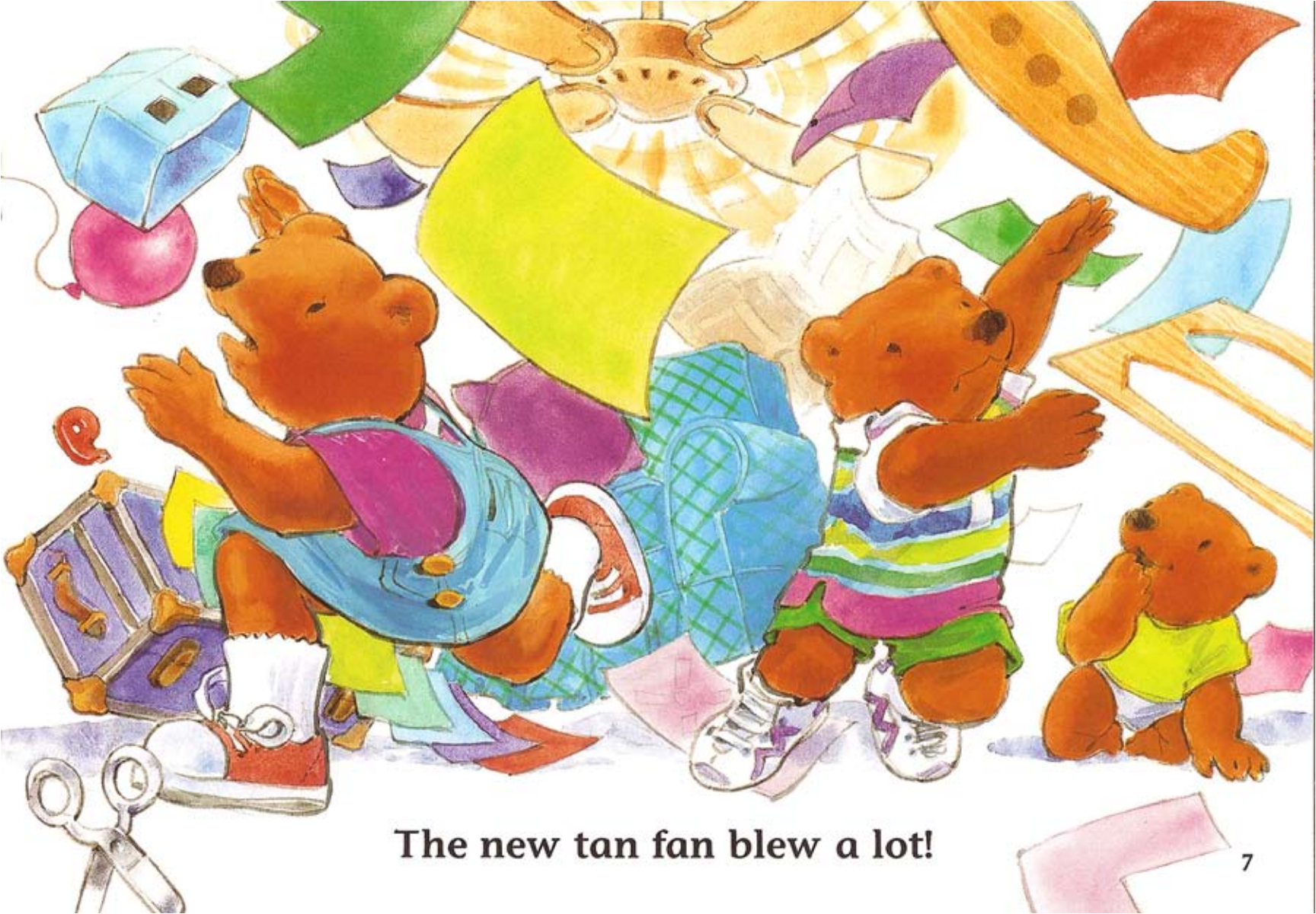
"Mom," said Pam, "put the new tan fan on."

Interactive Reading Idea
