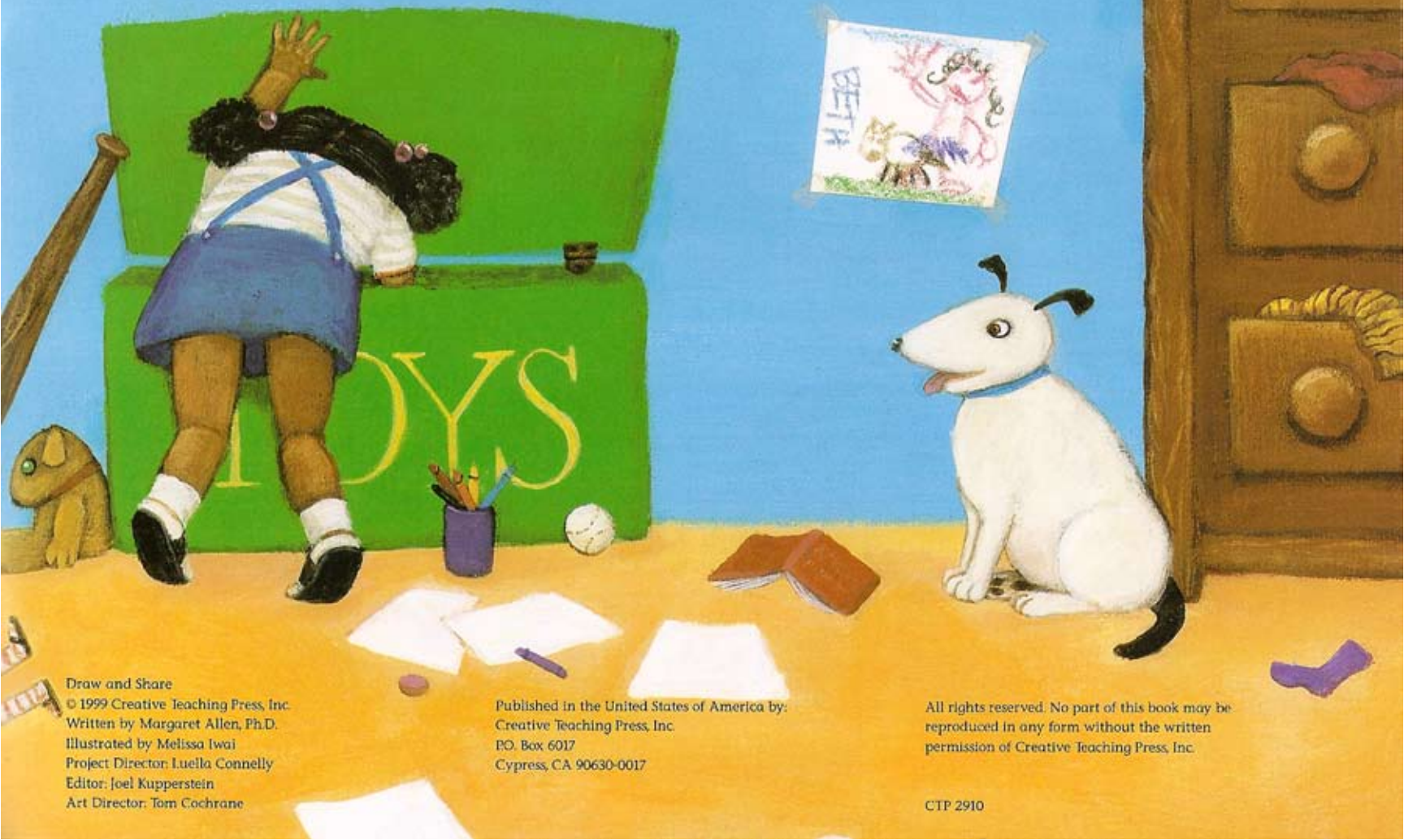

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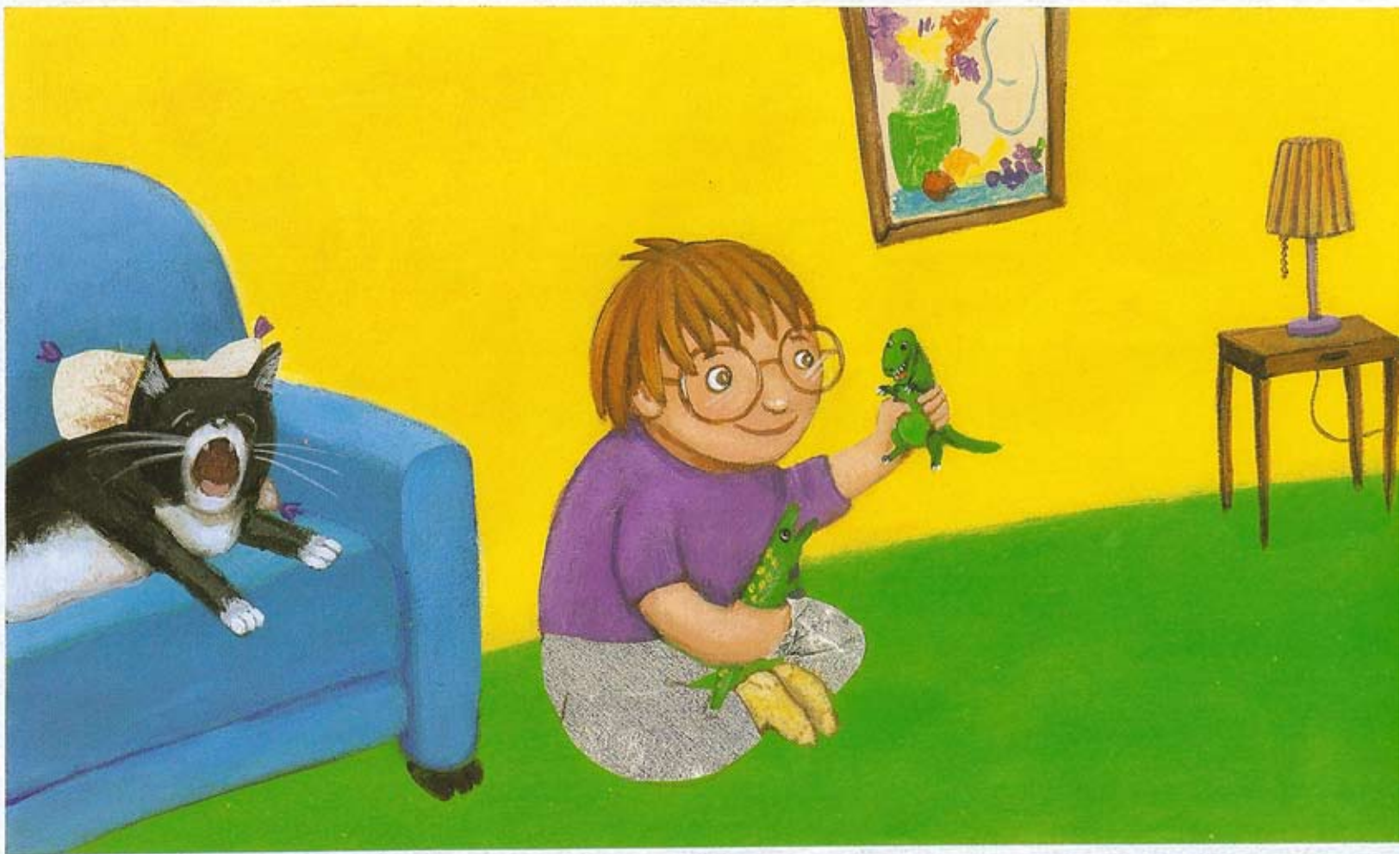
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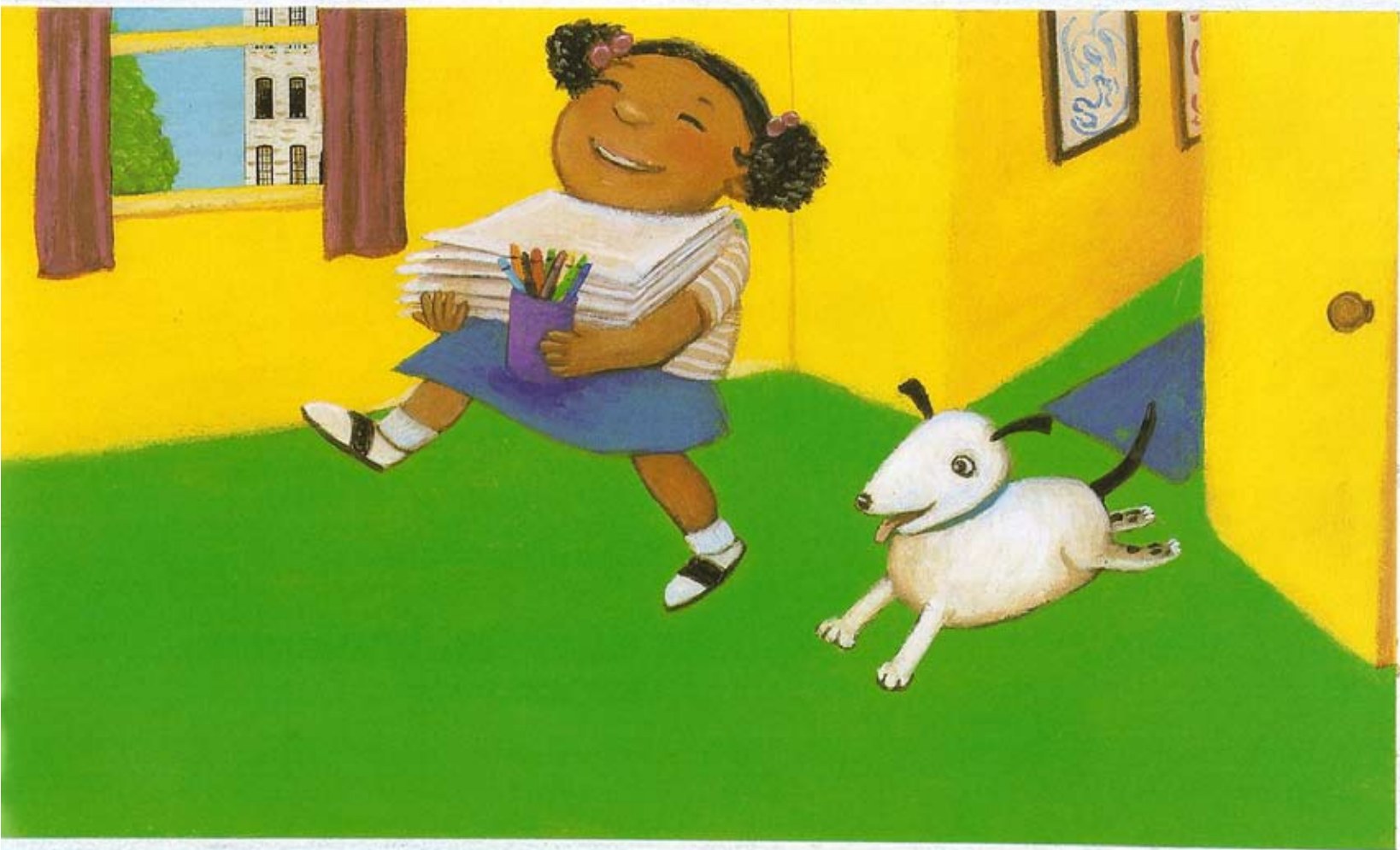

“Let’s play Draw and Share,” said Beth.



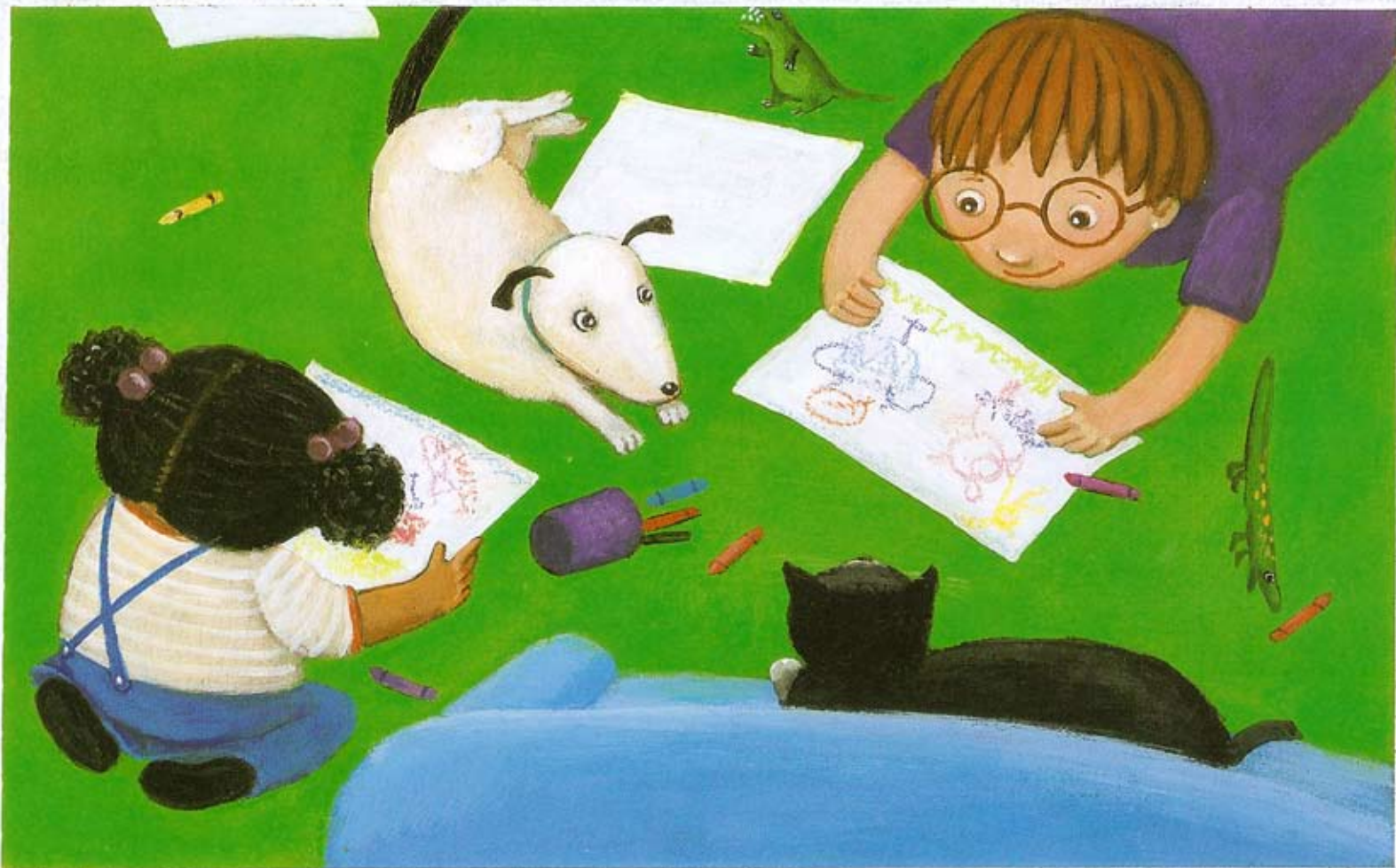
Chad and Beth plan what to draw.



Chad said, "I will draw a pig and a drum."



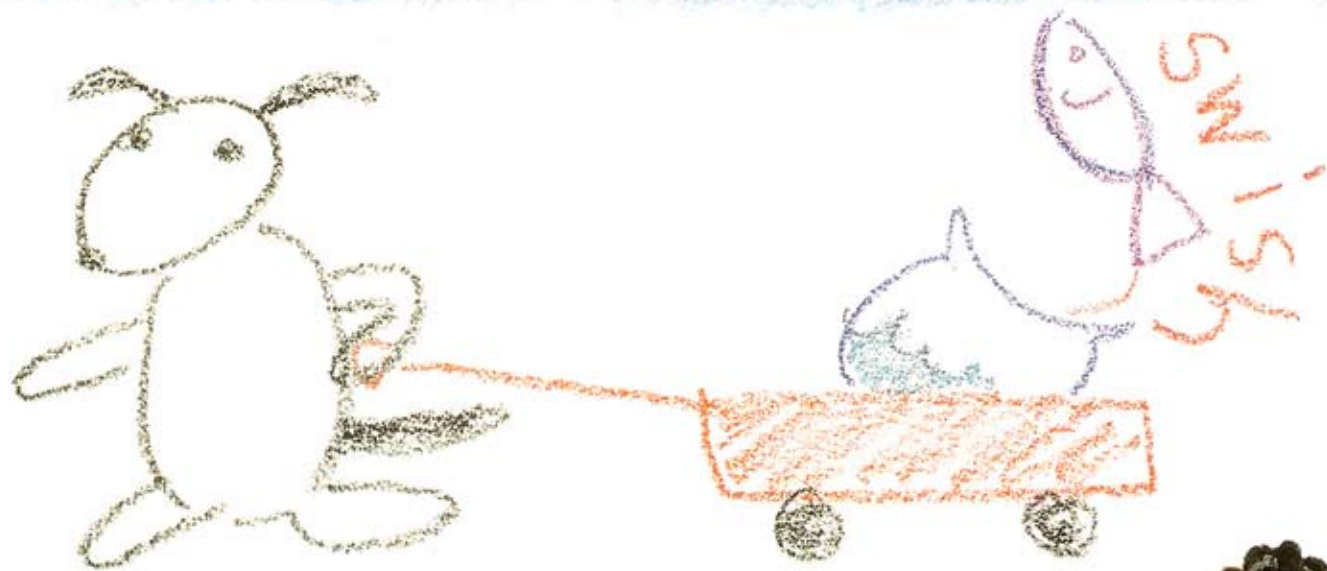
Beth said, "Then I will draw a dog and a fish."

“And a drum can hum.”**



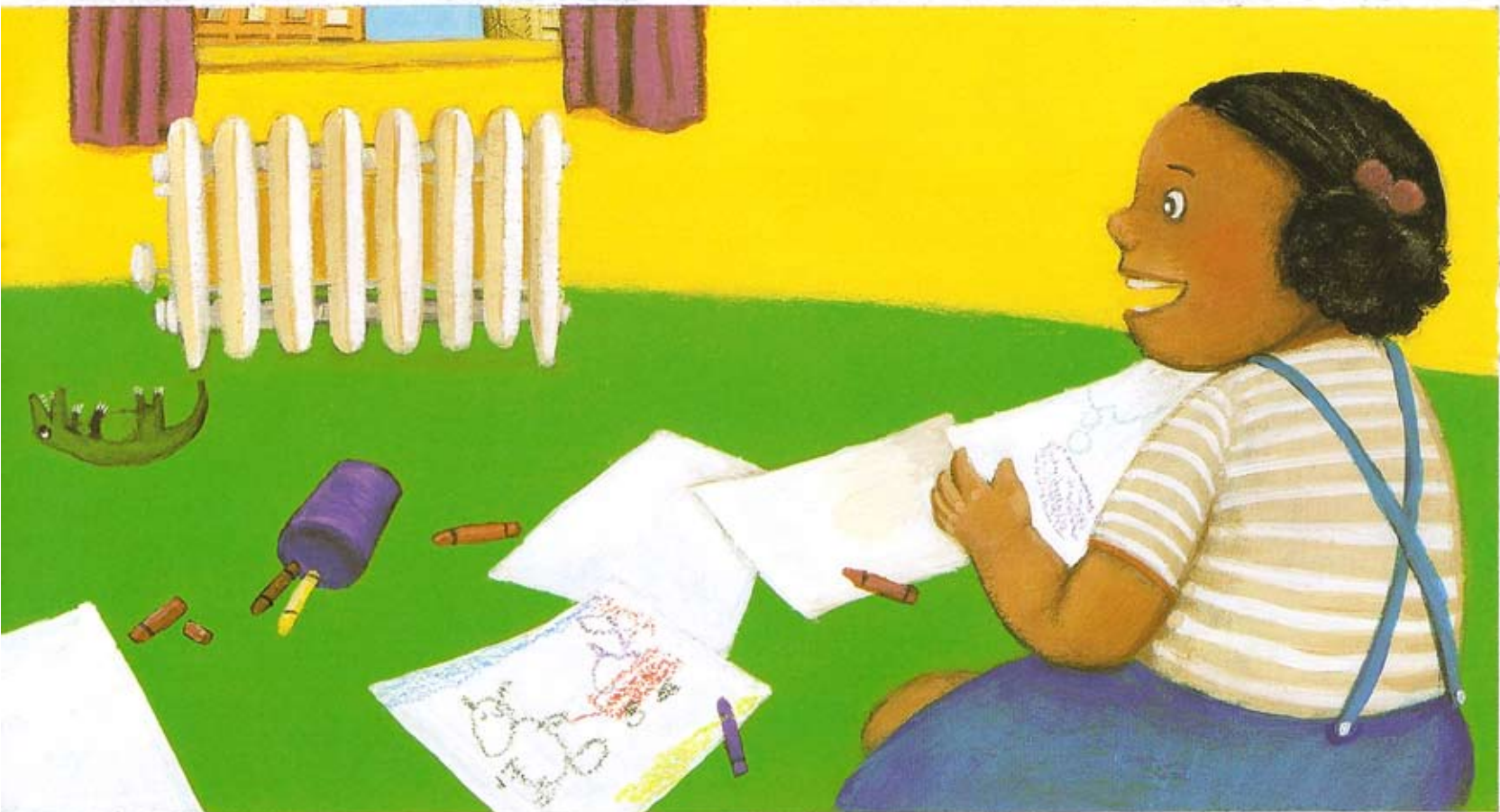
