**Vroom, VROOM, VROOM!**



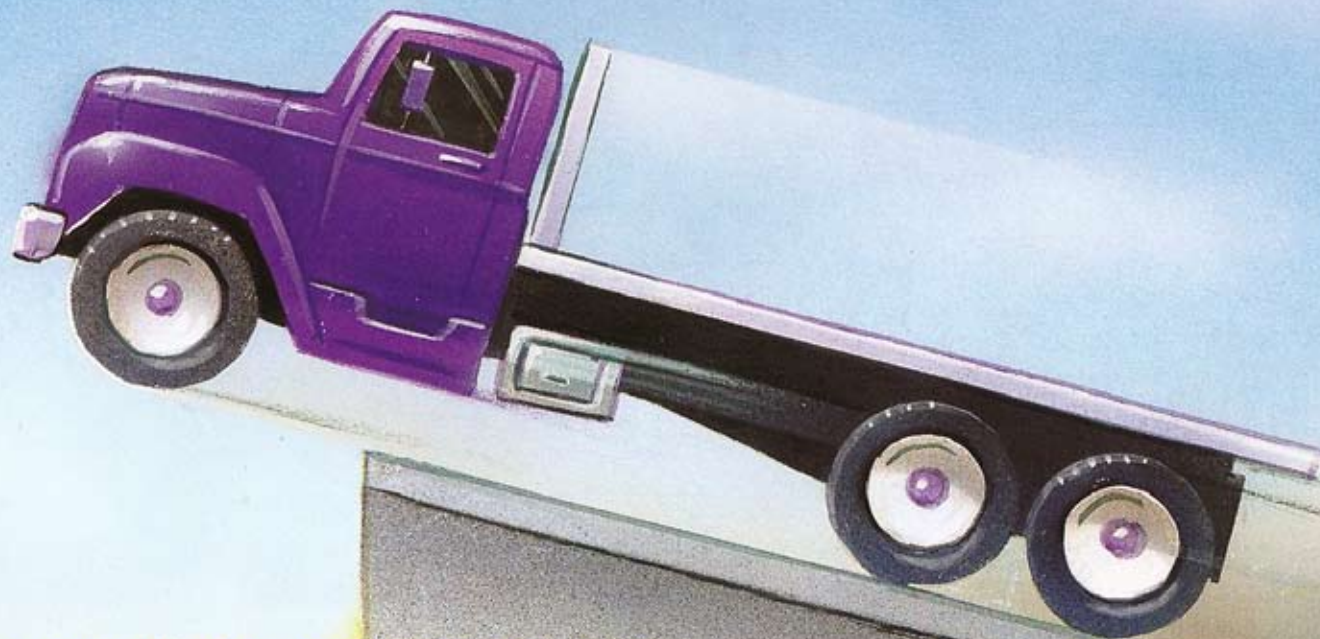
Zoom! Zoom!

The monster trucks do not go yet.





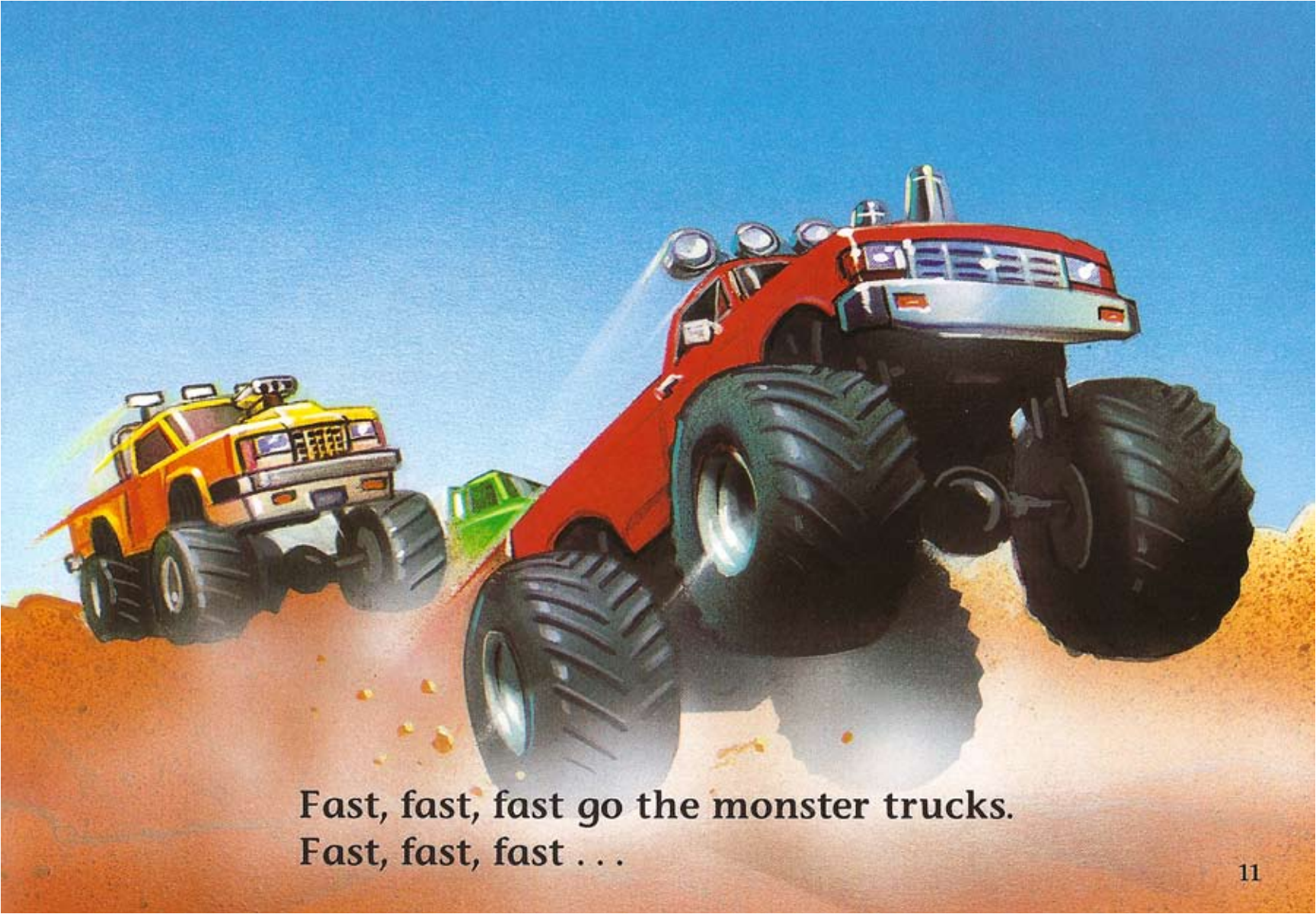
The flag drops.  
Off go the monster trucks!





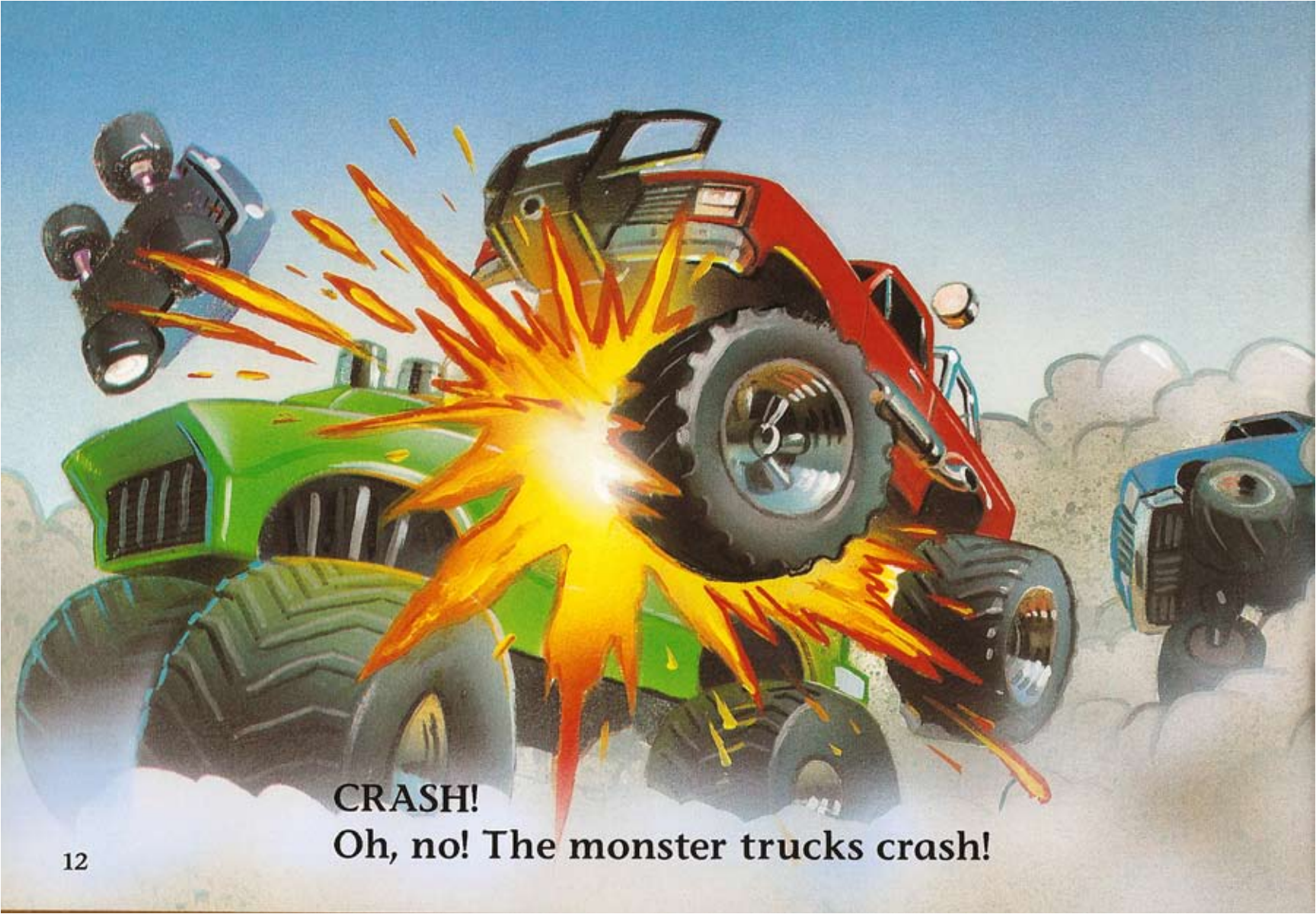
Vroom, VROOM, VROOM!

Fast, fast, fast . . .





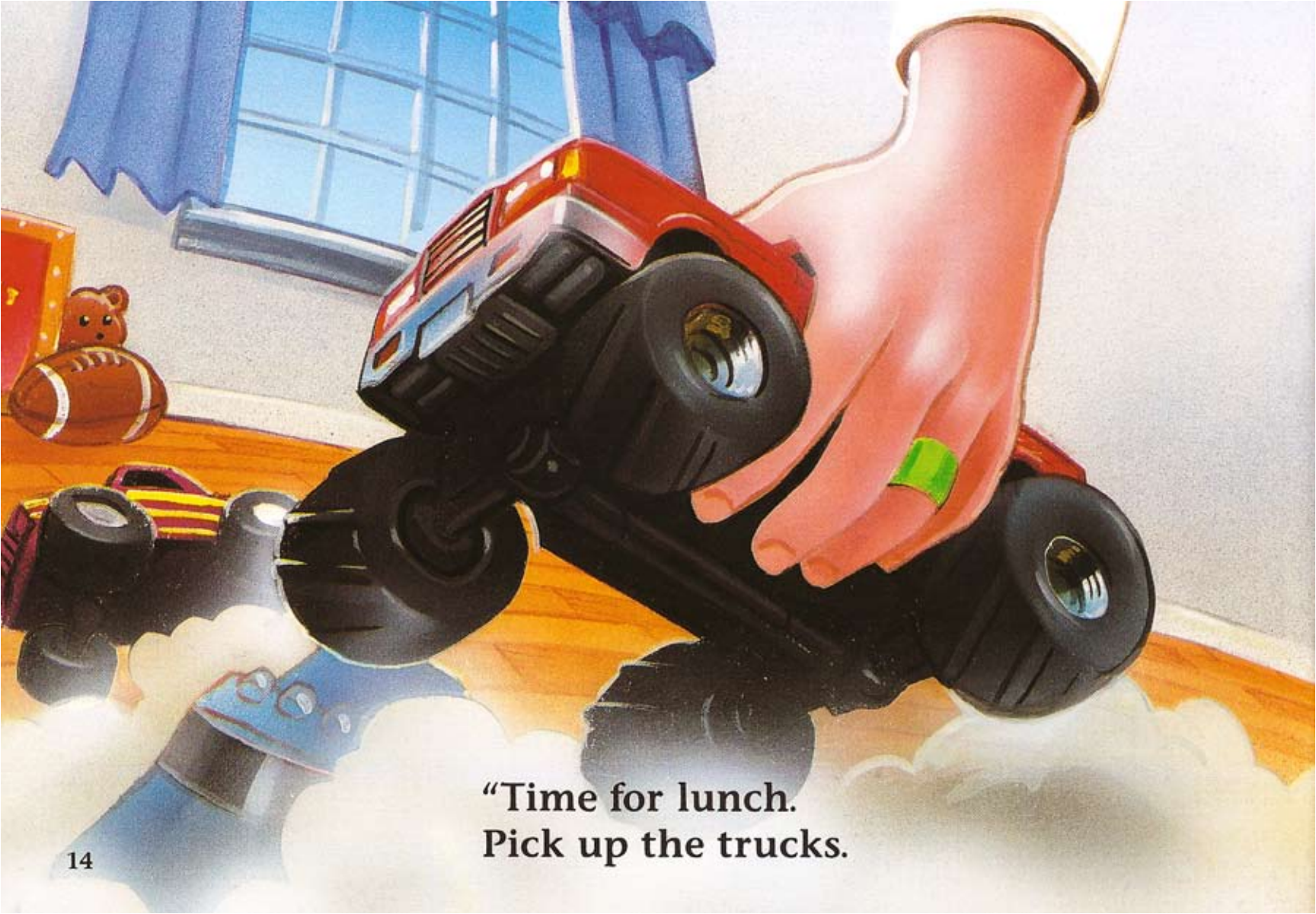
**CRASH!**  
Oh, no! The monster trucks crash!






“Chuck!” calls Mom.

### Interactive Reading Idea

After reading *Truck Tricks*, have your young reader draw the trucks from the story and label them by name—flatbed truck, monster truck, pickup truck. Encourage your young reader to write on his or her pictures sounds the trucks make, such as *vroom*, *whirr*, and *zoom*.
