

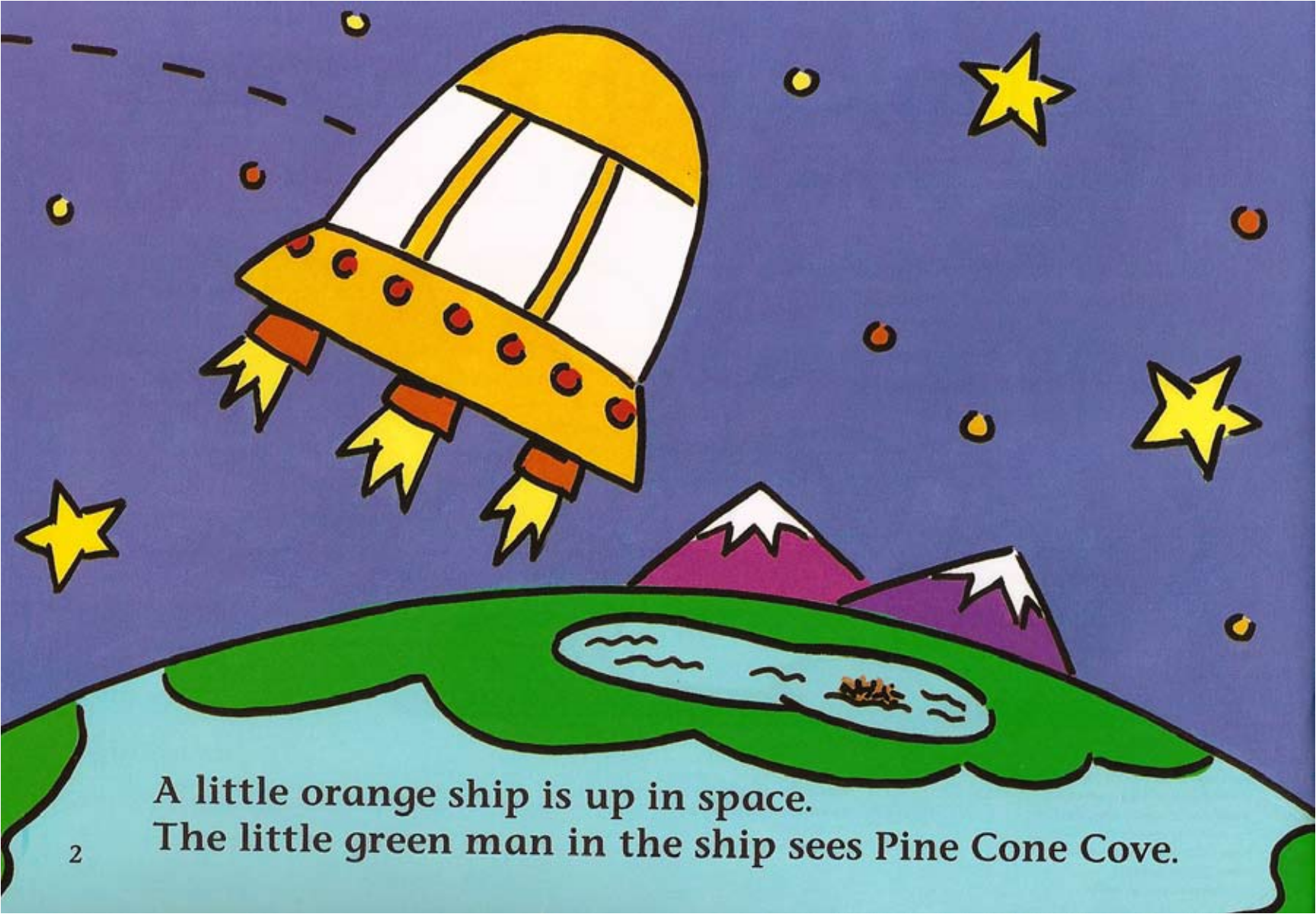

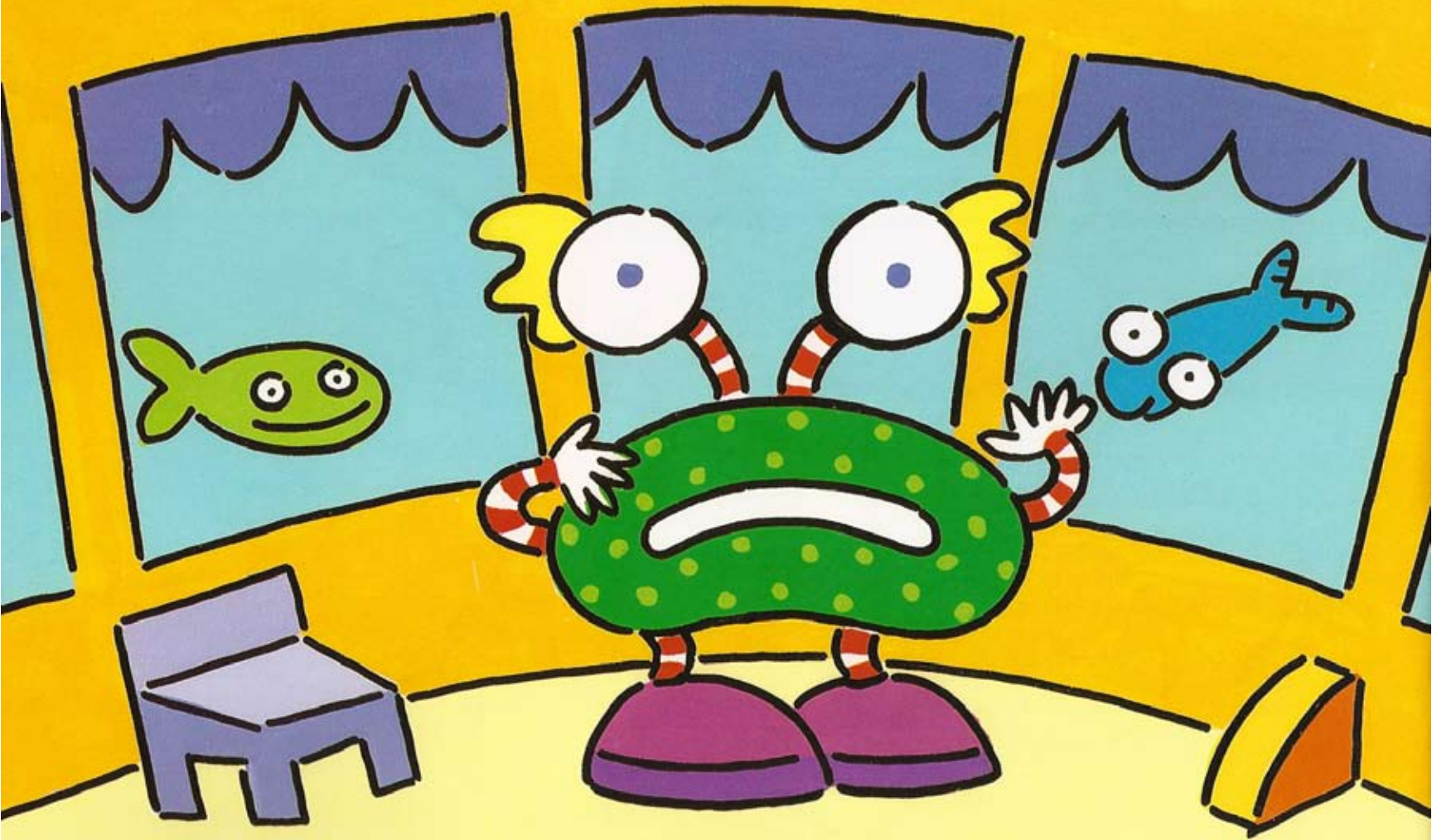


A little orange ship is up in space.

He lands his ship low in the cove.

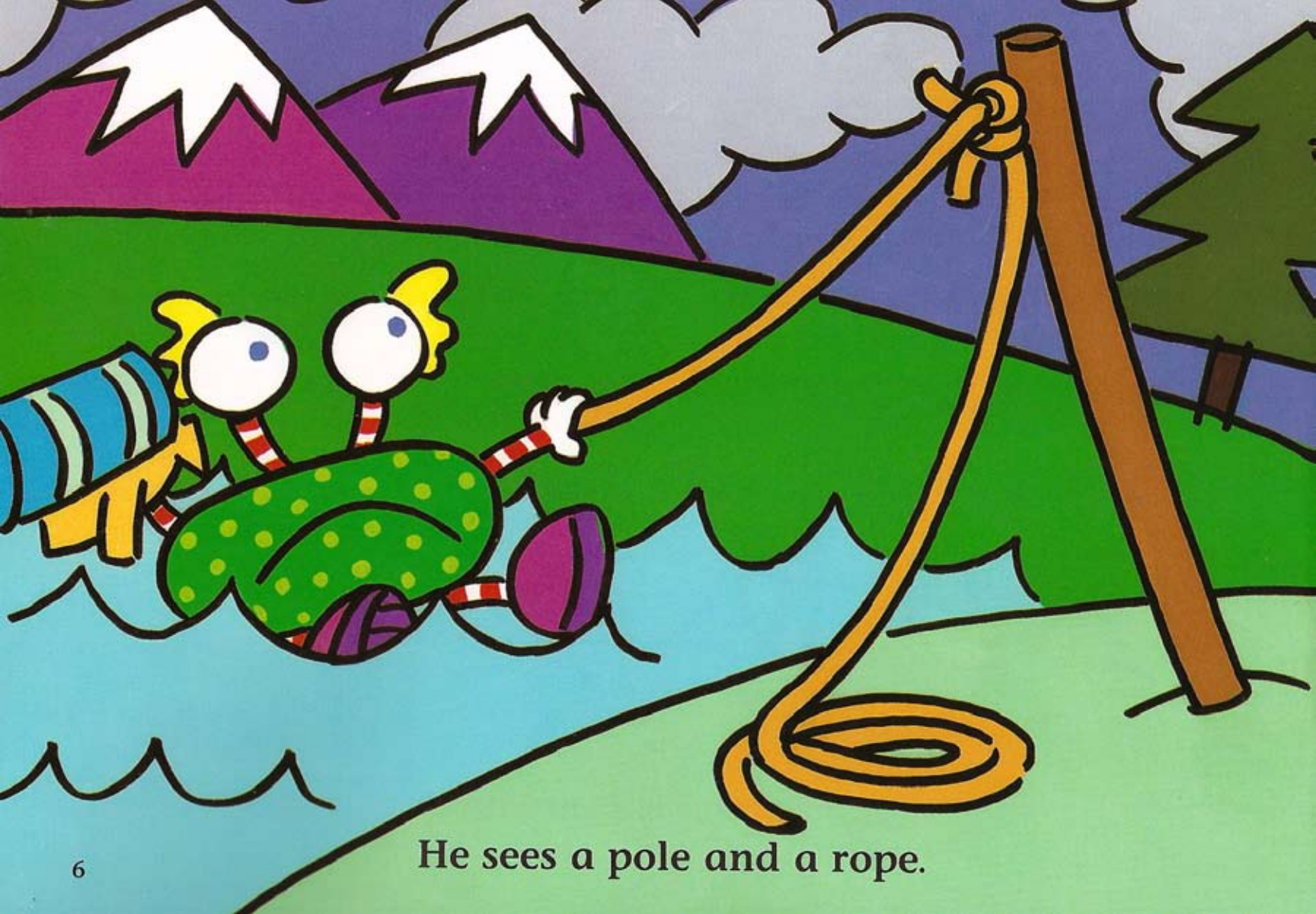


"Oh, no!" says the little green man.

He folds it.

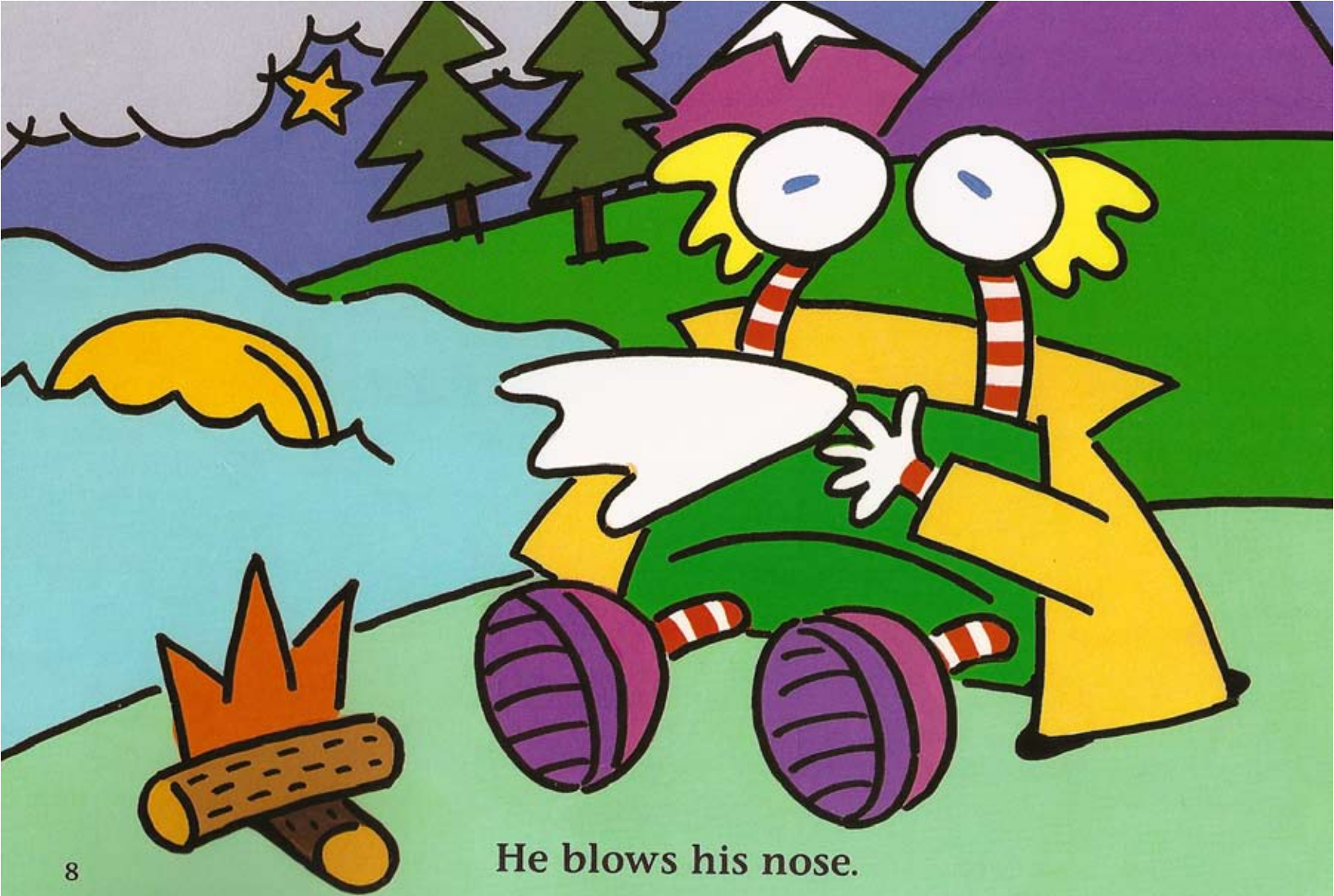


He sees a pole and a rope.

Jo Jo takes his boat into the cove.

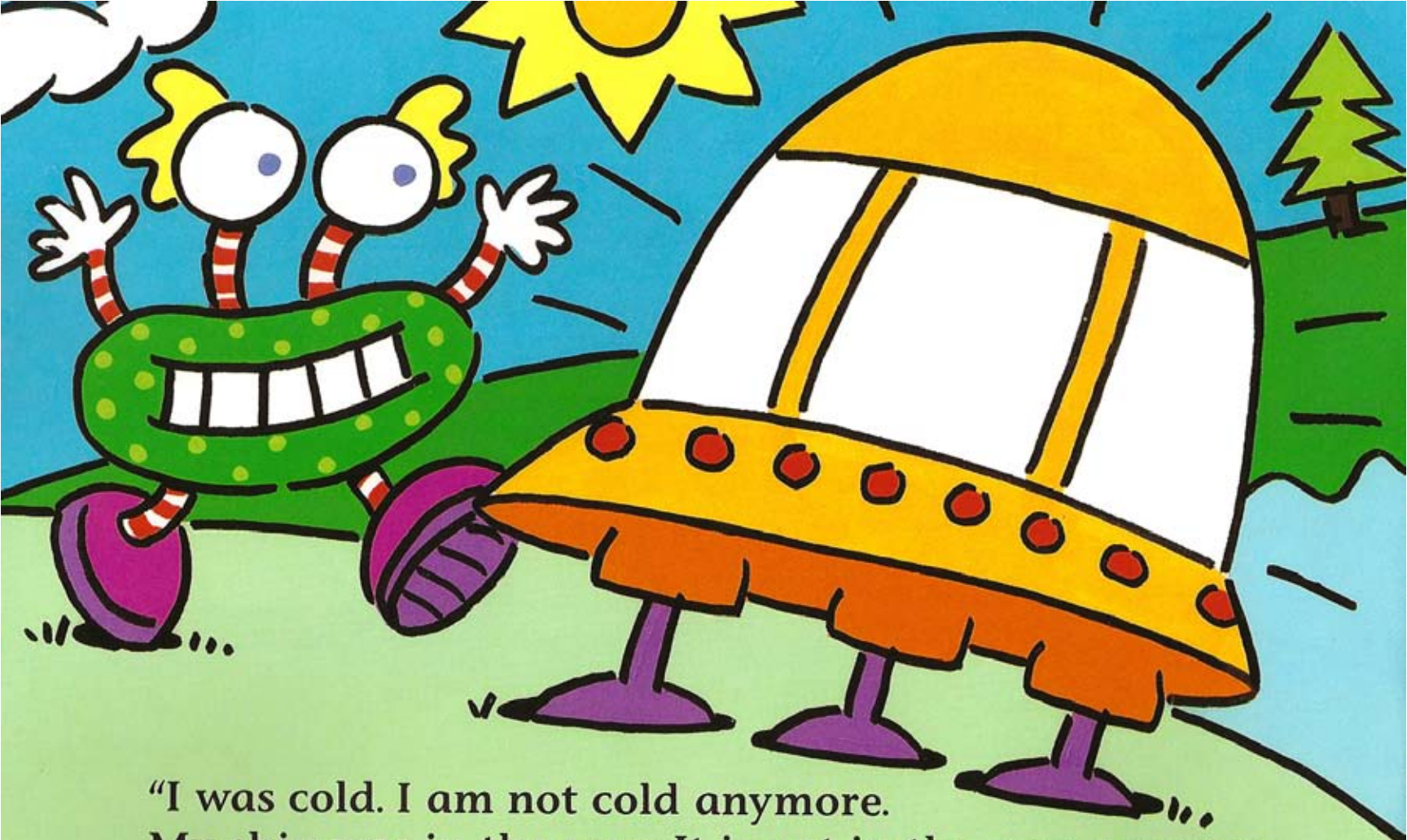


He dives in and tows the little orange ship.  
Jo Jo is slow, but he saves the ship. Then he hides.



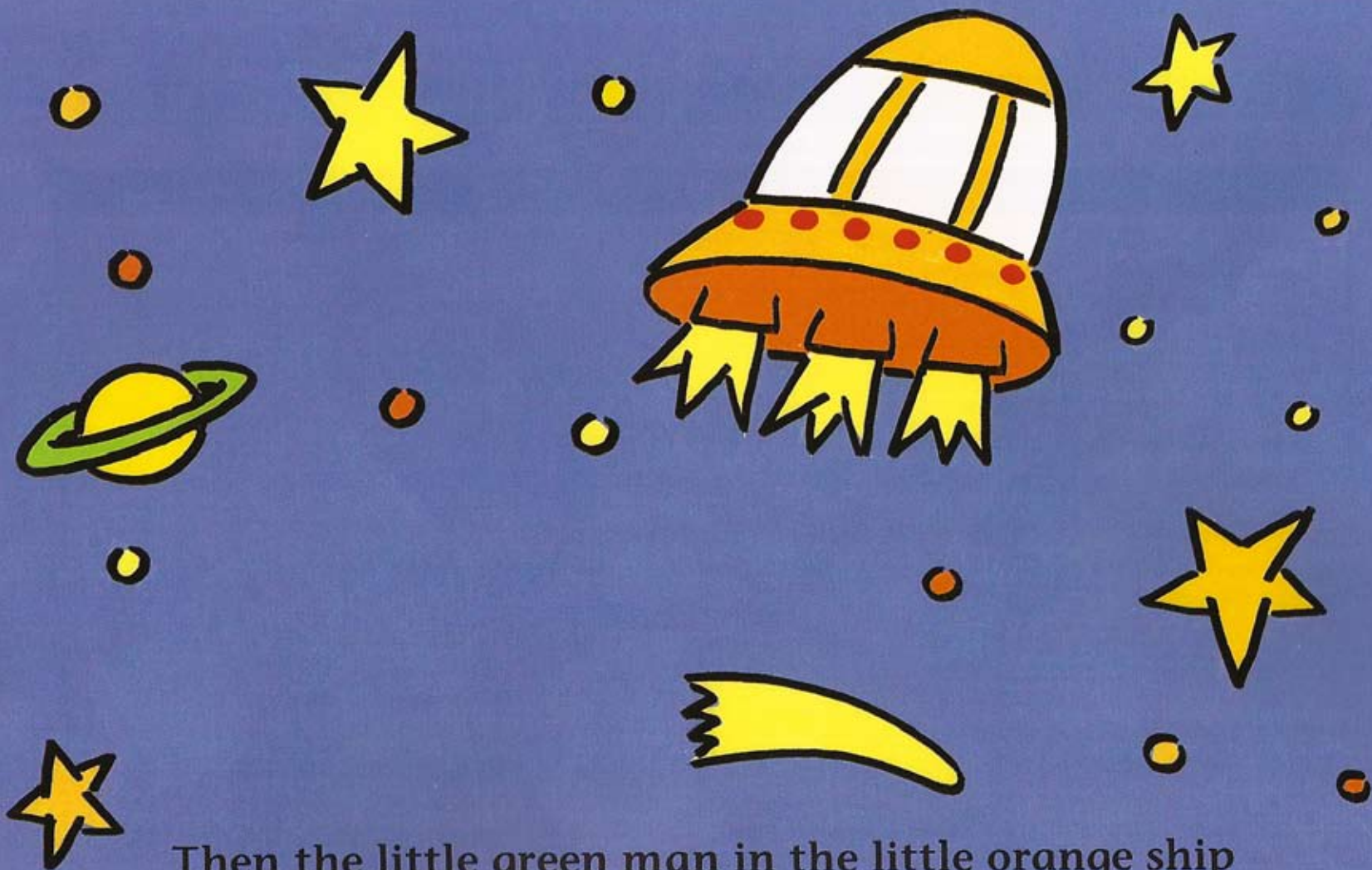


"Oh!" says the little green man.

**Focus-Skill Words** contain a new skill or sound introduced in this book.

**Sight Words** are among the most common words encountered in the English language (appearing in this book for the first time in the series).

**Story Words** appear for the first time in this book and are included to add flavor and interest to the story. They may or may not be decodable.

### Interactive Reading Idea

Challenge your young reader to find the words *cold*, *folds*, and *holds* in the book and write them on individual pieces of paper. Help your reader create puzzles by cutting off the first letter of all three words and the last letter of *folds* and *holds*. As the child reassembles the puzzle pieces, have him or her blend the beginning sound onto the *-old* word family and add the *s* sound to *f-old* and *h-old* to read *folds* and *holds*.
