




Mom says, "I have a great plan for you."

Let's play in our family's rainy day band.




I'll play the big glass jars. He'll play the tin lids. We'll all play, Mom, Dad, and the kids.

Join in Dad and Mom. We're ready for you.







Our band is ready. It's time to begin.
