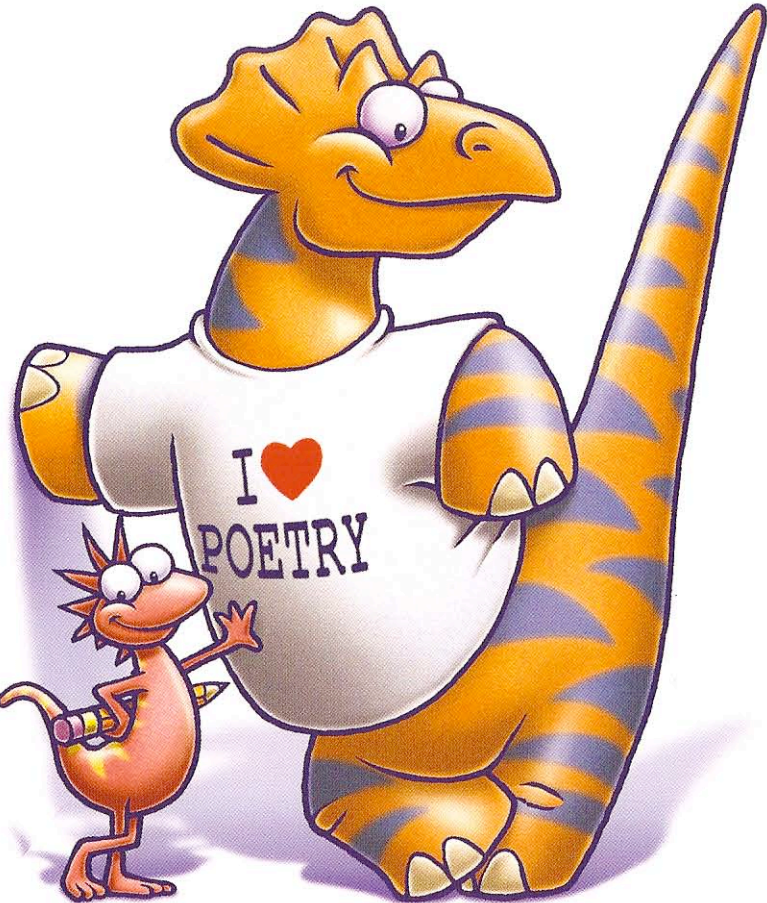

I can write a poem that rhymes.

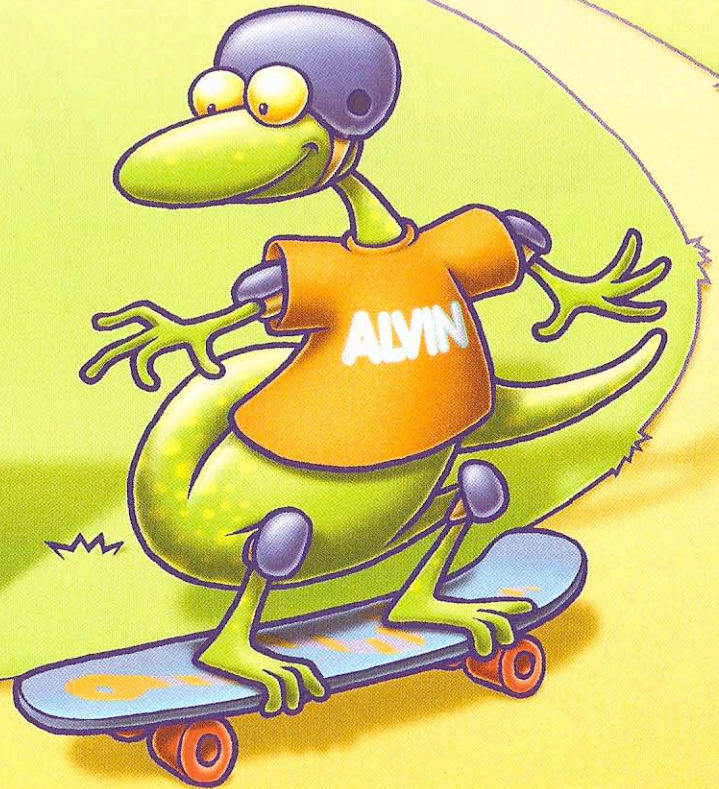
I can write one poem.

Little Bird and Little Bee

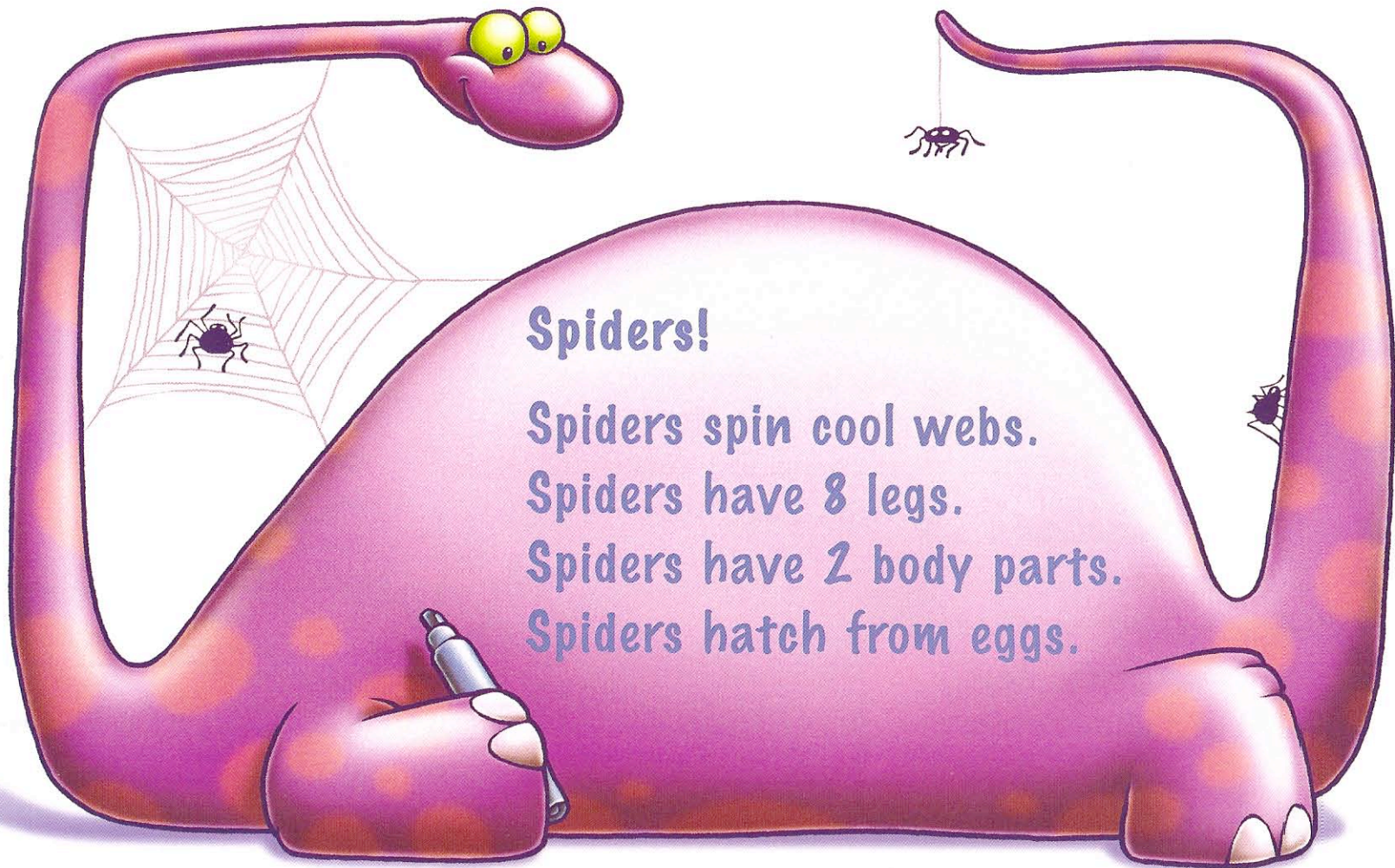
A little bird and a little bee

I can jump like a frog.



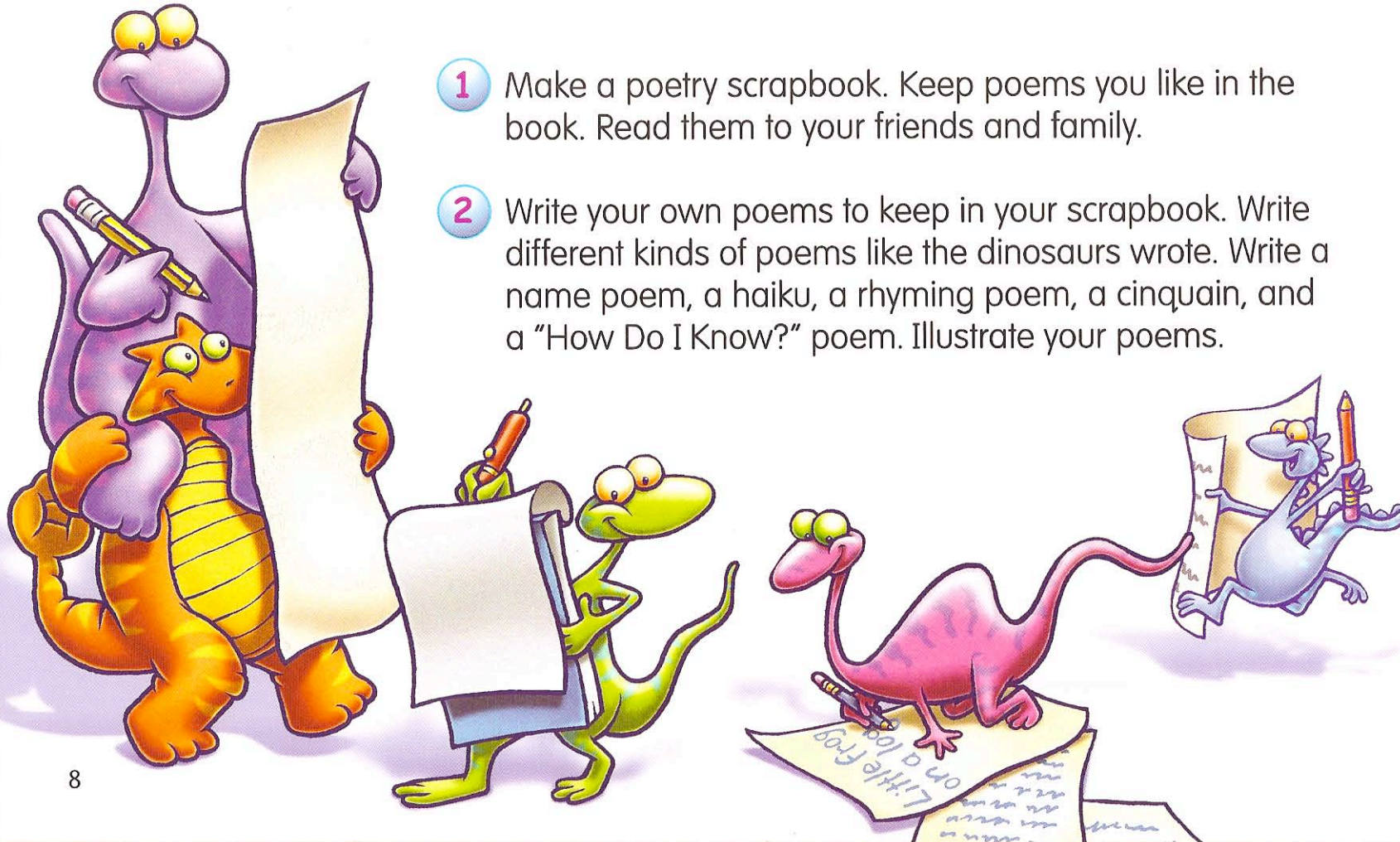
I can write two.
