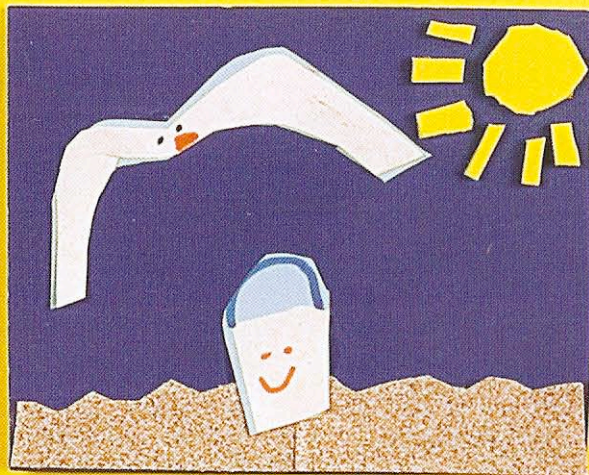
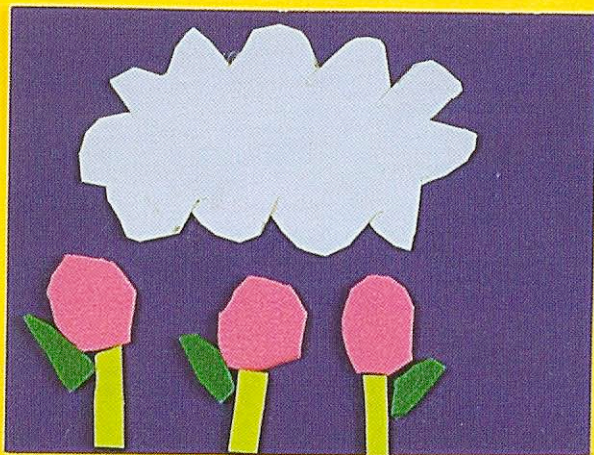


Seasons

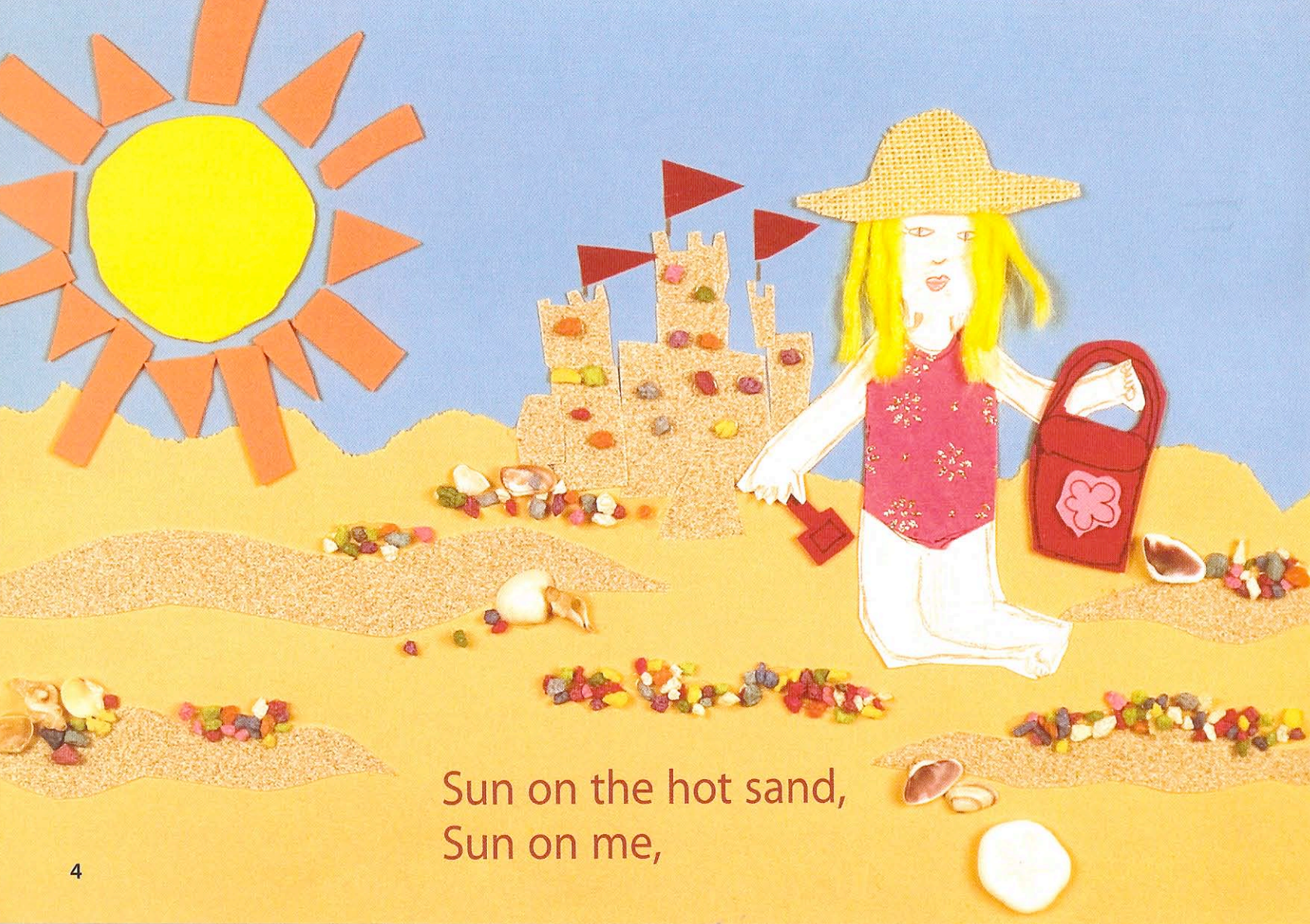




Rain on the green grass,

But not on the trees!

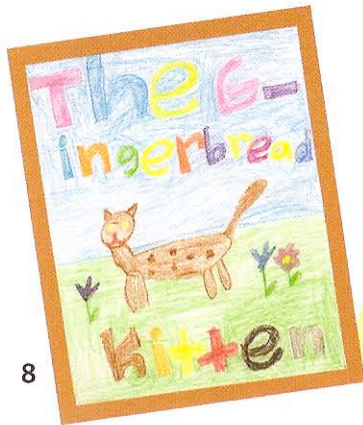


Snow on the houses,
