


# Fairy Tale Mail

Little Old Woman






Dear Littles, *May 16*

The Queen

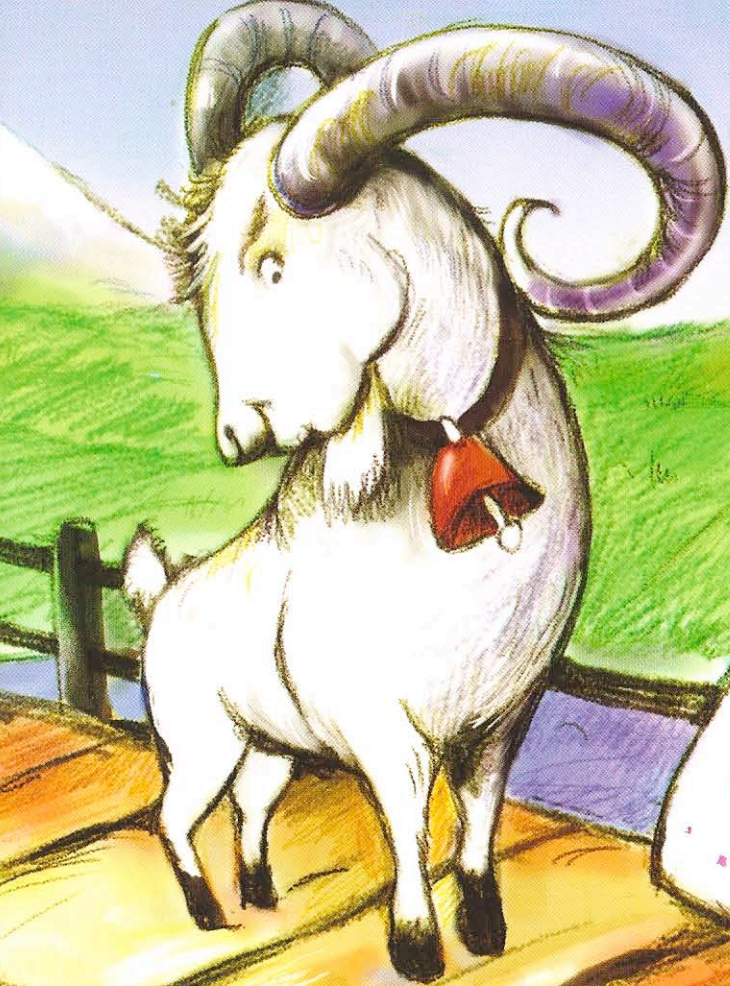




Dear Queen, May 17

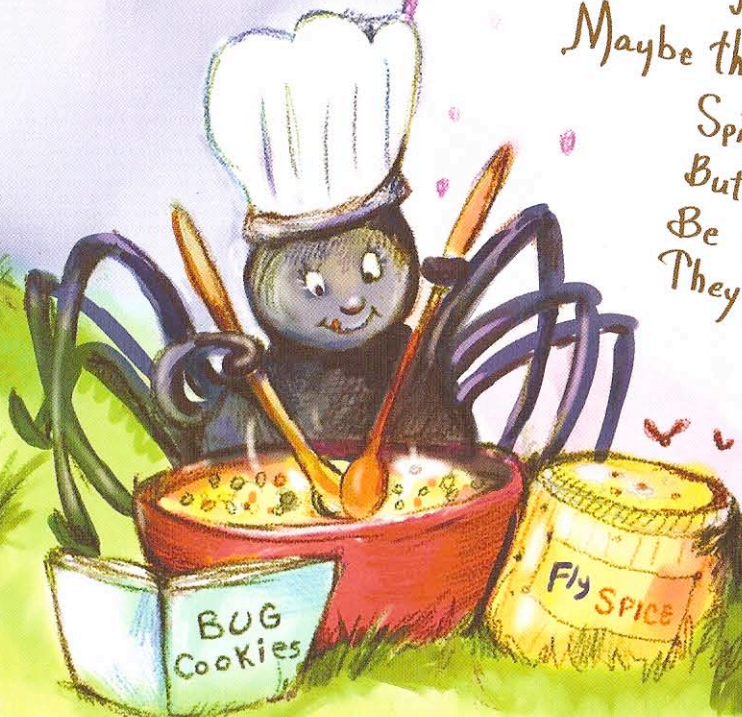


May 23

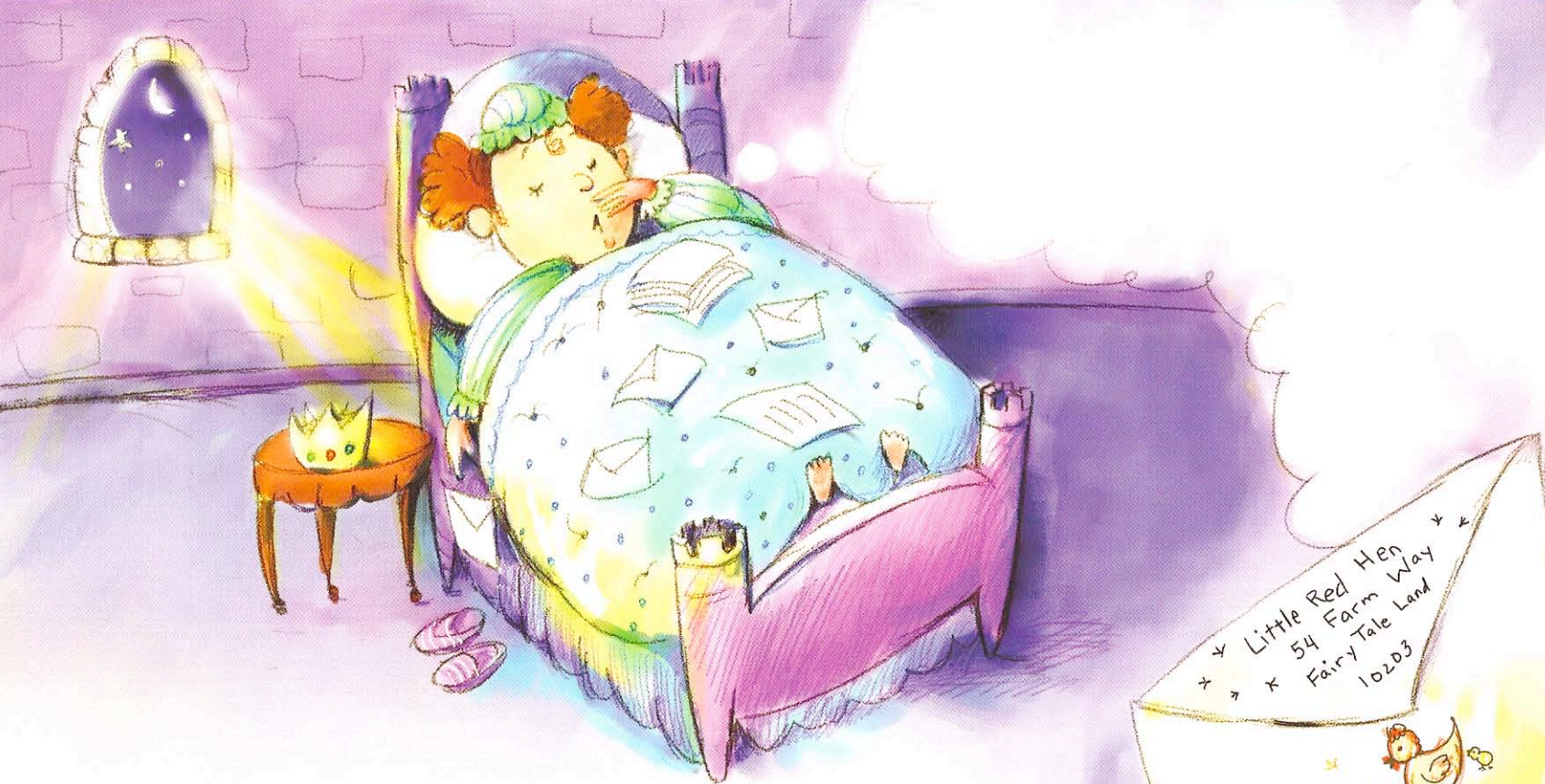
