What you have here is essentially a heavy-duty shower gel, housing flecks of pumice suspended within a clear base. It's gentle enough to use regularly—definitely gentle enough to use throughout the holiday weekend. The pumice makes short work of dry skin and calluses, while a series of extracts (passionflower fruit, green tea, willow bark and deep sea algae) soothe and hydrate the skin. I like how this smells, too; it's clean and appealing, with notes of citrus and wood.
