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## COPPER GLOW

A pure Kanchipuram silk saree with checks on the body. You'll find intricate mango bhuttas nestled within the checks on quite a few traditional Kanchipuram silk sarees as it is a very well-known design. But, we have re-established it as a traditional long border in copper zari. This design is popularly called as "kattam manga bhutta".



A lavender coloured pure Kanchipuram silk saree with embossed floral patterns on the body. The pista green coloured border has a traditional lotus bhutta in copper zari, shaded with silver zari inside.





Made of pure Kanchipuram silk, this saree is woven in the same style as our Magna collection with just one rose bhutta on the body in copper zari.

striking orange, rich with zari work.









## Pochampattu

We've merged the grand old tradition of Kanchipuram silk with the well known tradition of Pochampalli.

The new Pochampattu collection now comes with intricate, fascinating Pochampalli patterns and motifs across the border of our authentic Kanchipuram silk sarees.

This Kanchipuram silk saree is striking red, like the colour of kumkum. What makes the saree so unique are the peacock bhuttas with a splash of zari as the background of the body and the Pochampalli border in blue, green, red and white, levelled up with a thick bavanji pet gold border.



This green silk saree has huge checks in silver zari on the body and a Pochampalli border that is in shades of pink, green and mustard. The pallu of the saree is a contrasting twilight blue with simple silver zari stripes.







A yellow Kanchipuram silk saree with peacock bhuttas encased in a circular frame woven with silver zari, complete with a blue, red and green Pochampalli border.
