Woven for comfort and designed to look beautiful and elegant. It showcases self-coloured bodies with solid bold colour borders and geometric patterns. Come indulge in an exciting line of sarees that you can wear at work or play.





Magenta is a traditional favourite in terms of colour scheme.

Paying ode to this tradition, we've created this saree using this palette for the bhuttas and the pallu. It also adorns big heritage motifs placed throughout the saree and traditional striped patterns on the pallu, some including a line of bhuttis, kalamkari patterns and contemporary waves.





Using a subtle colour palette like coral green and peach, this palette seems unusual for a Kanchivaram or Corporate wear. The body is embossed with tiny thread peach bhuttas on a green body whereas the border is grey with peach bhuttas. The pallu is definitely a show stealer, you can let it loose or pleat it up based on your mood.







Interplaying pastel shades like moss green and rustic pink, the body of the saree has bhuttas nestled within the striped checks on the border. These checks are woven with earthy brown silk threadwork. The pallu is found in a bright shade, but the body has a subtle shade to make ass balance. The designs also carry out tis balance with a modern design on the body and the pallu owning a traditional zari weave.





Magenta is a traditional favourite in terms of colour scheme. Paying ode to this tradition, we've created this saree using this palette for the bhuttas and the pallu. This saree has a zig-zag hexagon pattern in beige, light blue and purple. Maintaining a bold blue body throughout, just as multiple business suits do, this saree means nothing but business. We haven't used any bhuttas to give the saree an official feel.







Beige is seen as a corporate colour, and we've used that to our advantage with this saree. Maintaining its simplicity throughout, it has a large border with geometric patterns strewn on it. There are spirals and triangular bhuttas woven in coral green. The pallu consists of rich zari which can be pleated up to shimmer your way through your office with poise.





A traditional colour palette of mustard and brick red, that's known more synonymously with religion. Our sarees draw this inspiration because 'work is worship'. The colours seamlessly work with each other. The body is simple with heritage palm sized bhuttas and beautiful threadwork is woven on the red pallu in several different design elements.








Using two beautiful bold colours, this saree a peach body and a blue border. The body has minute blue bhuttas that are embossed in rich threadwork. We've steered clear of the standard bhutta work that most working sarees have. The bhuttas though seemingly small, promises a good design visibility.

The smartest feature of the saree is the pallu, it is rich with zari, but it can be pinned up in pleats at work and let down for an evening that follows.





Using a highly corporate colour, light brown and teaming it with a little pink quirk is what we did here. The bhuttas on the saree are done in an intricate candy pink silk threadwork. Though the pallu is bright pink, we've made a subtle appearance, using an elaborate Banarasi inspired close knit threadwork on it.
