In this puzzle is 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9 = 33

7. This will bring you to your next clue, shown below which is by the number 33. Before starting you should ensure you are correct by using the Checker. This is done in the same way as the first but because it is the 2nd Clue you add the number in the star to the first:

A. Find the number in the star next to the clue, here it is number 13.

B. Add number 13 to the number from the first clue:  $4 + 13 = 17$ .

C. Look in the Clue 2 row of the Checker to see if you can find the number 17.

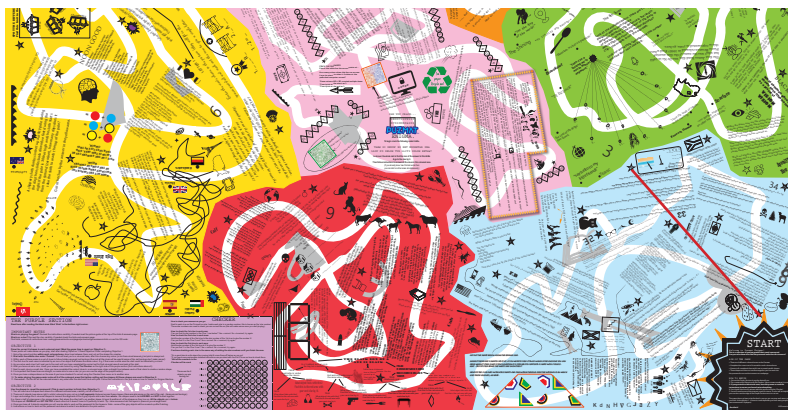


If you can find it then this means you are correct, cross it off and continue. If you can't it means you are in-correct and need to try again until you are at the right clue.

NOTE - the checker continues like this with a running total. However for each new area start again from the number in the star by the first clue and in the Clue 1 row of the Checker.

8. Now you can confirmed that you are in the right place you can draw a straight line between the stars of the 2 clues:



9. Repeat this process of answering the clues, checking you are in the right place and drawing a line between the stars until eventually you come back to the start, cut out the shape created at the end. Note - not all the clues will be used, some are red herrings.

10. After finishing blue attempt any of the colours except pink - pink is done last. Remember the starting clue is always the only clue with an icon that shares the same colour as the area it's in e.g. if there was a purple area this could start with the icon of a lavender flower.

11. After starting pink you will notice it is completed slightly differently to the other areas, please follow the instructions from the first clue. Note - it is not checked in the same way as the other areas.

12. After you have 6 shapes you can move onto Objective 2 which is much quicker than the first and explained in the bottom left corner of the purple area.
