

product instructions

instructions (even ours) can be boring, but they are required by “big brother.” at least they are somewhat short:

getting started your blackout curtain arrives ready-to-go; just unfold it, figure out whether you want to cover a wide or narrow window, adjust the width, apply a few (or all) of the silicone hooks... and hang it. how's that for an elevator pitch?

IMPORTANT NOTE: our silicone hooks are super strong... but only when firmly applied. so... press firmly around the edges so all bubbles are removed. that will insure they stay in place. to remove the hooks, slowly peel from window (and don't break a nail).

installation

- 1) it's rectangular. so eyeball your window and adjust your curtain width (using the small squeeze balls at the end of the ropes) to match the general width of the opening.
- 2) **apply the silicone hooks (all or a few). again... press them down hard to remove all bubbles. that is the key to making them stick firmly in place.**
- 3) now hang your curtain from the hooks. it should fit generally well, but if sloppy at all, just adjust the width narrower or wider so the rope is generally taut.

{#hiccahint}

make sure you practice with it a few times to get the hang of it, because all windows and doors are shaped differently. you may have to adjust a couple of the hooks to better line up with the support ropes. but rest assured your curtain works with all windows (as long as they have glass in them).

washing frankly, you will probably never need to wash it. ideally, just wipe it down with a light solution of mild soap and let it hang dry. **NOTE:** the supplied silicon hooks will continue to stick to windows if they are kept clean and dry. should they get dirty... just wash them off, let them dry and re-stick firmly.

{#hiccafact}
