

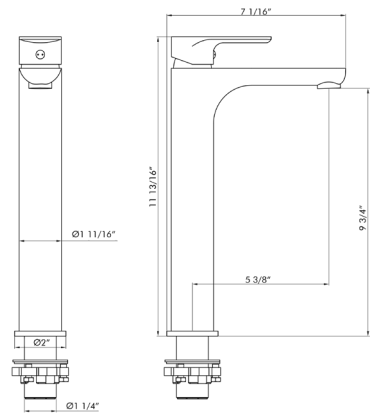

## Product Care.
