## How to Use Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Hose Connectors

Step 1: Remove any existing vinyl Step 2: Install Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ by cuff by twisting off in a clockwise direction.

twisting on in a counterclockwise direction.


Step 3: Attach female Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ end to machine by twisting in a clockwise direction.


## Lubrication of Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Hose Connectors

Use PTFE grease to regularly lubricate the rubber gasket on the male Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$. This will ensure your Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ are always easy to twist on.

Lubricate the rubber gasket where indicated in Figure A.


## Connecting Hose Segments Together



To connect two 1.5" hoses together, use the H655 coupler. Keep the standard vinyl cuffs on your hoses. Slide one vinyl cuff from one hose onto the H655 coupler, then slide a cuff from the other hose onto the other end of the coupler.

To connect two 2" hoses together, use the H110 and H138 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$. Remove the standard hose cuffs from your hoses and install the H110 on one and the H138 on the other. Screw the H138 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ into the H110.


To connect 2" hose to 1.25 " hose, use the H138
Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {m }}$ on the 2" hose and the H122
Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ on the 1.25 " hose. Screw the H138 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {m }}$ into the H122.

To connect 2" hose to 1.5 " hose, use the H138 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {m }}$ on the 2" hose and the H141
Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ on the 1.5 " hose. Screw the H138 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{T M}$ into the H141.

To connect 2" hose to 2.5 " hose, use the H106 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ on the 2" hose and the H108 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ on the 2.5" hose. Screw the H108 Cuff-Lynx ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ into the H106.

## Connecting Hoses to Cleaning Tools

2" hose to 1.5 " tool


Use H142 hose cuff. Thread the 2" end of the H142 onto the 2" hose. Slide the 1.5" end over onto the cleaning tool.
1.25" hose to $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ tool


Use H301 hose cuff. Thread the 1.25 " end of the H301 onto the 1.25" hose. Slide the 1.5 " end over onto the cleaning tool.
