Thread the retention strap through the product like this



When you place the bag onto the rack there are two triangular clips on each side which hang over and hook over the dropout hooks on your rack. (In case your rack doesn't come with dropouts, the bags come with two extra hooks that you can attach yourself.)

There's a reason they are called "saddle bags" – the two bags straddle over the rack adding storage to both sides. Once the retention strap is threaded you attach the triangle ring to the rack, or our preferred location – at the dropout, using the two small hooks we've provided. Adjusting the straps so there is a little tension helps this process



Shown above: The two options for attaching the hooks to the rack/bike.

- 4 Once the triangle rings are hooked on, tighten the strap that runs between the panniers to get it snug enough, and slide the strap over the front of the rack to prevent the panniers from sliding off the rack.



The upward bend in the rack should be located in back of your saddle. The nylon Webbing strap goes around this lip and is tightened.
