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Feelings: Friendship

Objective:

To encourage children to make friends and value friendships.

Materials:

- Construction paper, assorted colors
- Markers
- Scissors
- Tape
- Stapler
- Heart (Page 6)

Preparation:

- Cut paper into 8"x1"
- Draw several hearts on posterboard then cut them out.

Introduction:

• Ask the class: "What is a friend?" Possible answers:

Someone to play with Someone you like and who likes you Someone who shares

• Explain friends are important and we must always treat them the way we want them to treat us.

Activity:

- Children will cut out and color the heart (Page 6).
- Write their name in the center of the heart.
- Give them paper strips and ask them to decorate and write the names of their friends on each strip.
- Glue the strips to make a chain. Hang the chain on your heart to create a friendship chain.



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Closing Activity:

- Invite some of the children to share their "Friendship Chains" and talk about some of the special things they like to do with their friends.
- Hang the chains around the room.

Follow-Up Activity:

• Have the children make a special card for a friend. The front could say, "I'm glad you're my friend." Inside: "Because _____." (Let them fill in the blank.)
