PRETTY AND PREGNANT

ACTIVITY ONE

- 1. Ask learners what they think of this story. Have they ever found a friend or themselves in this situation?
- 2. Select a volunteer to act out the role of Tawanna. What kind of person is she? Ask learners if they would do things differently if they were in her shoes.

ACTIVITY TWO

- 1. Have learners perform a role-play of Tawanna, five years later. Does she have a job? What is her life like?
- 2. How about 20 years from now? What values would she teach her child?

ACTIVITY THREE

- 1. Encourage learners to give some reasons why they think Tawanna would have been better off not becoming involved in a sexual relationship.
- 2. Ask the group: If a young girl becomes pregnant and has a baby, what does she miss out on? Some answers may include *parties*, *hanging out with friends* and *going to the beach*.
- 3. Direct learners to create a list of things they can do with their boyfriend or girlfriend to have fun, instead of activities which lead to having sex and babies. Examples may include *movies*, *picnics*, or *playing video games*.
